Dear Wolseley School families,

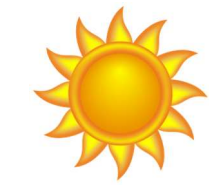
Spring Break is a great time to recharge and to get ready for the final learning block of the 2025-2026 school year.

With the weather getting nicer outside, it might be a good idea to pack extra socks for your children, so they are not sitting with wet feet all day.



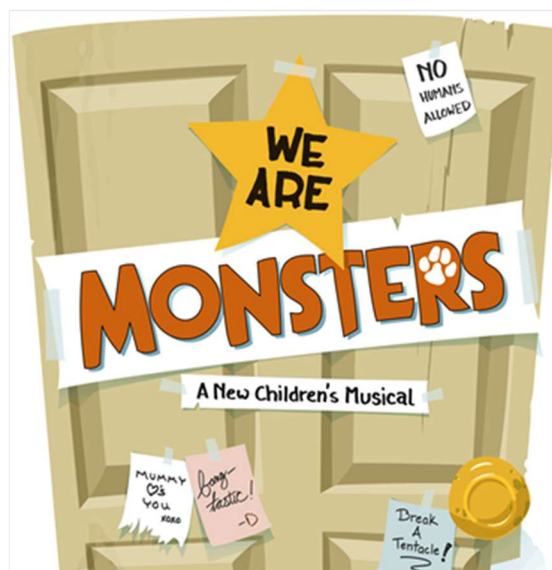
