Cash can be paid at the school office.

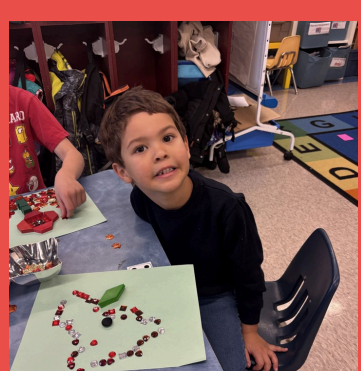
