Dear École J.B. Mitchell Families,

We hope this message finds you all only partially frozen after the frigid temperatures we have had over the past few weeks...Winnipeg winters are truly something! Good thing we have lots of diverse learning happening inside the school to keep us all warm and engaged!

Although January brought a lot of indoor recess, we are hopeful that February will give us lots of opportunities to be outdoors! We provide frequent reminders, both over the announcements and in individual classrooms, about the importance of students wearing appropriate winter clothing outside. Thank you in advance for reminding your child(ren) about this at home as well. We also continue to speak with our students about our school expectations of respect, responsibility and safety during all parts of the school day and especially at recess time. For recess, students are encouraged to use equipment appropriately, use snow for building and pulling sleds (NOT throwing) and listen to ALL school adults the first time. Thank you for any support you can provide at home in terms of reminding your child(ren) about these important expectations.

Valentine's Day is coming up this month. This day is a wonderful opportunity for teachers to talk about friendship and community in each classroom. We ask that if your child is planning on distributing cards at school that all students in your child's room receive a Valentine's Day card. Your child's classroom teacher will be reaching out with further class specific information about the celebrations. **In terms of Valentine's treats, we ask that students only bring a treat for themselves because we have many students with allergies, therefore we want to prioritize the health and safety of all of our students!** We know this is a disappointing message to some, however the health and safety of all our students is always our first priority. We thank you in advance for ensuring that all snacks are nut free.

There are many other fun activities happening in our school in February. Our Kindergarten students in both Rooms 108 and 112 will be giving a presentation for their families on Friday February 13th in the library. Other fun activities across our school this month include performances by both the Contemporary Dancers as well as Damien Lussier. We will also be holding our Winter Fun Day on the afternoon of February 20th.

We would also like to take a moment to remind families of some important safety information that applies to streets around our school.

- Please remember that our Stop Drop and Go Zone is located on John Brebeuf. Students being dropped off at the Stop Drop and Go Zone must be able to independently walk themselves to their **designated lineup location at the back of the school**.
- We have school safety patrol students on duty before and after school, as well as at the beginning and end of lunch hour. For the safety of all students and families, we ask that you cross with the patrols or where we have a crossing guard whenever possible.
- A reminder for families about the time restrictions on turning in specific directions from Grant Avenue and Lanark Street at the overhead crossing. Many vehicles are ignoring this signage and we are concerned for the safety of our families and our school adult crossing guards. We respectfully remind all families to adhere to this signage to help us keep everyone safe.

A final reminder that we have an open house to share information about our school on Thursday February 19th at 6:00. If you have family or friends looking at school options in our neighbourhood, please encourage them to attend. More information about school registration will be shared with families in the coming weeks.

Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) Clinic

This CRA clinic offers one-on-one help. Register to reserve a spot. You can register by phone, online or at any Winnipeg Public Library.

This clinic helps with the following services only:

- Applying for benefits (CCB, GST, DTC)
- Answering personal tax questions (no trusts, business or farming)
- Updating information (address, direct deposit, contact information)
- Printing letters or Proof of Income Statements (Option C)

Registration opens 2 weeks prior to event date at 10 a.m. You can register for one CRA clinic only at a time. On the day of the CRA Clinic, the order of when you are seen will depend on when you check in at the branch. Check in starts 30 minutes prior to the clinic start time. Limited walk-ins will be taken if time allows, or if spots are not yet filled.

Help Your Child Succeed in School: Build the Habit of Good Attendance Early

DID YOU KNOW?

- Starting in preschool and kindergarten, too many absences can cause children to fall behind in school.
- Missing 10%, or about 2 days each month over the course of a school year, can make it harder to learn to read.
- Students can still fall behind if they miss just one or two days every few weeks.
- Being late to school may lead to poor attendance.
- Absences and tardiness can affect the whole classroom if the teacher has to slow down learning to help children catch up.

Attending school regularly helps children feel better about school—and themselves. Start building this habit in preschool so they learn right away that going to school on time, every day is important. Eventually good attendance will be a skill that will help them succeed in high school and college.

When Do Absences Become a Problem?



Note: These numbers assume a 180-day school year.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

- Set a regular bedtime and morning routine.
- Lay out clothes and pack backpacks the night before.
- Keep your child healthy and make sure your child has the required shots.
- Introduce your children to their teachers and classmates before school starts.
- Develop backup plans for getting to school if something comes up. Call on a family member, a neighbor, or another parent.
- Try to schedule non-urgent related medical appointments and extended trips when school isn't in session.
- If your child seems anxious about going to school, talk to teachers, school counselors and other parents for advice on how to make your child feel comfortable and excited about learning.
- If you are concerned that your child may have a contagious illness, call your school or health care provider for advice.
- If your child must stay home due to illness, ask the teacher for resources and ideas to continue learning at home.

Student Absence Reporting/SafeArrival

At Winnipeg School Division, one of our top priorities is ensuring that every student arrives at school safely each day. To help with this, we are using student absence reporting system called SafeArrival. This system streamlines attendance verification, make it easier for you to report your child's absence and assist staff in responding to unexplained student absences more efficiently.

With SafeArrival, you are asked to report your child's absence in advance using any of these 3 convenient methods:

- 1.) Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at <https://go.schoolmessenger.ca>). The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence. When searching on the App Store, type “School Messenger” and select the Blue App.
- 2.) Use the SafeArrival website, <https://go.schoolmessenger.ca>. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence. When you go online, make sure you are on the Canadian website (ending in .ca). If you are on the U.S. website (ending in .com), you will not be able to access the school account.
- 3.) Call the toll-free number 1-855-278-4513 to report an absence using the automated phone system. Please make sure you go online and set up a PIN. Please keep this PIN private.

If you have not consented to Electronic Notifications and Emails at the school, or if your email on file at the school is incorrect, you will not be able to access the SchoolMessenger App or the SchoolMessenger website. Please contact the school office to make changes to your email on file.

If your child takes the bus and will be absent you must call the transportation department at 204-789-0452
