- Please note that events on this calendar are subject to change.

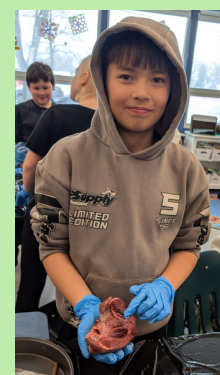

March in like a lion. We completed the month of February on a high note. Storytelling Evening marked the end of our month long – I LOVE TO READ month. With storytelling and stew in mind, we welcomed more than 200 families to the evening celebration. Classroom teachers showcased storytelling in different formats. We were also entertained by Rob Malo, a local storyteller who delighted us with his passion for his Metis culture combined with storytelling. The evening couldn't be complete without stew made by the Culinary Arts students from R. B. Russell High School and a roaring fire outside. During the month of February, we welcomed guest readers to come read to our students. We welcomed Mr. Mike Moroz, MLA for River Heights, Mr. Mark Wasyliw - MLA, Constable Paul with WPS, Anthony Coombs, a former CFL player and Sarah Oresky - Sports Reporter. We also had the pleasure of having former staff, Ms. Daeninck and Ms. Devlin, come read to our students.

We also had the pleasure of welcoming the Indigenous Sky Teachings to our school. Students learned about the role Indigenous Perspectives play in astronomy and rich oral stories. On Monday, February 23, students learned about Indigenous People using the (IPAC – Indigenous Peoples Atlas of Canada), which is a large floor map. This learning was led by a staff from the Indigenous Support Team in the WSD. On Tuesday, February 24, we had a makeshift planetarium set up in the gym. Students from Nursery to Grade 6 learned about the importance of stars and the connection to Indigenous People.

We completed the month of February with a Winter Day/Festival Day celebration. However, due to the extreme winds, we had to take our planned outdoor activities, indoors. All the students had a blast. We celebrated Metis heritage at its' finest.

The weather is very unpredictable. We ask that you send your child(ren) to school ready for the elements. Students often will say to us that they do not need their jackets on. We allow them to make these choices; however, it is important that you stress that their safety is of the utmost importance. We will do our best to reinforce the same message here at school.

Report Card season is here. Term II report cards will be emailed out on March 17th (online). Student Led conferences will be an opportunity for your child to lead you through their learning. The conferences will be on Thursday, March 19th from 3:45 pm to 7:00 pm and on Friday, March 20th from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm. We will once again be using school interviews, a computer application for you to book the desired times for the conferences.

We have begun planning for the 2026-2027 school year. Please communicate your intentions for next year to your child's classroom teacher if you have not already done so.

Next PAC meeting is on Monday, March 2nd. It is an online meeting. A link to the meeting has been sent out. Meeting is at 5:30pm on TEAMS.

We will be finishing off the month of March with Spirit Week from Monday, March 23 to Friday, March 27. More details about the week will be shared with you as we get closer to the end of the month.
