
We also encourage parents/guardians to not park in the staff parking lot or the daycare parking lot. Please do not block the exits and entrances. This is not safe!

Please come to the office when you are picking up your child(ren) early and we will call them down.

All grade 1-8 students will go to the school field (south side) when they arrive in the morning. Staff in vests will assist in directing students to the field after 8:45 am, **there is no supervision before 8:45 am so please remind students to come for the 8:50 am bell.** Students will enter the school from the field when the bell rings.

If the weather is -28 degrees or more students will be let into the building at 8:45 am.




