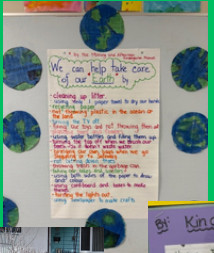


A MESSAGE FROM MS. MANNES...

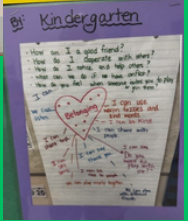
