We cannot believe that we have only two months left of the school year! Time flies when you are having fun! The students have been having a lot of fun with their learning and with the various activities that they have had the opportunity to participate in.

As the weather is warmer and children are out riding bikes and scooters, we are asking that parents remind their children to be safe and follow the traffic signs. If your child brings a bike or scooter to school, please be aware that they are not to ride around on the playground or front area during school entry or dismissal times. Approximately 900 students exit the school at 3:30, therefore it is not safe or permitted to ride bikes/scooters until reaching the sidewalks off school property. This will avoid collisions and keep everyone safe. We really appreciate your understanding on this matter!

A gentle reminder that parents/guardians are to pick up their children outside at the back of the school. Since the start of the school year, grades 1-6 classroom teachers walk their students out the back at 3:30, therefore parents should be waiting outside at the back at their meeting place.

Another very important reminder is to NOT PARK in the bus loop. School busses need to be able to enter the bus loop and not be blocked by parked cars! If you need to drive, please park on Jefferson or on a side street. Please do not enter the school parking lot. We all need to work together and put safety before convenience!

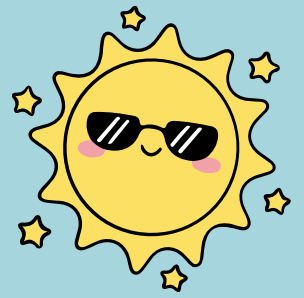
Safe Arrival attempts to contact parents/guardians at multiple contact numbers until the designated contact(s) is/are reached.
