Happy New Year from 102!

With a new year upon us, students in 102 are looking forward to continuing their learning. We are extra enthusiastic about our new inquiry (science and social studies) unit “Life in the North”. This unit takes us on an adventure, learning about the growth and changes in animals, as well as the Canadian community of Churchill, MB. Our unit began this week with making connections to our real world by watching an episode of the Arctic Vets show on CBC Gem. This show follows the Veterinarians at the Assiniboine Park Zoo, particularly the head Veterinarian, Dr. Chris Enright and his connection to assisting animals in Churchill. It is extra fun to watch this show because we actually get to visit the Zoo in the middle of the month and learn more about polar bears and other Arctic animals in person!

After we watched this episode, we began to ask questions that will guide our learning and find particular areas or animals of interest. We will then move into studying polar bears, adaptations that help them live, and the impact that global warming has on their home, and therefore the town of Churchill, MB. We will then move into studying more about Churchill, transportation to/from and within, what it is like to live there, as well as some Inuit culture. We are so lucky that an Educational Assistant in our classroom, Natalia, has a cousin that lives and works in Churchill! We are hoping to be able to have a video chat and ask an expert more about life in Churchill and the polar bears! We look forward to this exciting new unit! If you are curious about our learning we would love to share more of it with you, come by and ask us!



Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) Clinic

This CRA clinic offers one-on-one help. Register to reserve a spot. You can register by phone, online or at any Winnipeg Public Library.

This clinic helps with the following services only:

- Applying for benefits (CCB, GST, DTC)
- Answering personal tax questions (no trusts, business or farming)
- Updating information (address, direct deposit, contact information)
- Printing letters or Proof of Income Statements (Option C)

Registration opens 2 weeks prior to event date at 10 a.m. You can register for one CRA clinic only at a time. On the day of the CRA Clinic, the order of when you are seen will depend on when you check in at the branch. Check in starts 30 minutes prior to the clinic start time. Limited walk-ins will be taken if time allows, or if spots are not yet filled.
