

How does the program work?

Harvest staff and volunteers pack breakfast bags every week filled with healthy, and kid-friendly snacks including fresh dairy, fresh fruit and veggies, and an assortment of dry goods. Our friendly team of volunteers and staff will deliver the Meals2Go bags to your child's school every Friday. Teachers will distribute the bags to each student for them to take home and enjoy over the weekend!

Q: Are the bags free?

Yes! The Meals2Go bags are free meaning you do not have to pay to have your student receive Meals2Go.

Q: Who can receive the bags?

This is an inclusive meal program, everyone is automatically enrolled and will receive a bag each Friday.

Q: What if my child doesn't want one?

If your child would like to opt out of the program, please notify your homeroom teacher and child.

Q: Are the Meals2Go bags plastic?

No! Our Meals2Go bags are biodegradable!

Q: How long is the Meals2Go program?

We run the Meals2Go program for the entire school year, which means your child will receive kits every week from October-June. We do not distribute over the Holiday or Spring Break.

Q: What if my child has an allergy?

We will gladly pack a separate allergy friendly kit for your child that is sealed, labelled, and delivered in a separate bag.

Just let us know!

Q: Who do I contact with questions or concerns?

You can always reach out to your homeroom teacher with questions or school staff. You may also reach out directly to Harvest's Director of Community Programs, Mika Peterson, or Program Coordinator, Grace Hodge. They are always happy to answer questions or assist in any way.


