This year, we will be focusing on PBIS (Positive Behavioural Interventions and Supports) This model helps school become safe, caring and equitable. The main goal will be for all students to feel valued, connected and safe by caring adults. We strongly encourage you to support our Home Reading Program.

We are here to support you. If you have any questions about your child's progress, please feel free to contact the classroom teacher. Classroom teachers will connect with you through Seesaw. We are also just a phone call away. You can always arrange to meet in person with myself or the classroom teacher. Together we will support your child's learning.
