PROCEDURES / EXPECTATIONS

Welcome to a new school year. With our updated exterior doors' security system, doors will be locked at all times. We will continue to use designated doors to help with movement in and out of the school as follows:

- Room 113: Torwood Crescent (front doors)
- Rooms 208, 209: Lucas Avenue (bus loop doors)
- Rooms 212, 214, 215: Chisholm Drive (side doors)

If your child is late or entering the school after 9:15 a.m., please use the Lucas Avenue (bus loop) doors.

Our School Parking lot is reserved for staff parking only. Street parking is available along Torwood Cres., Chisholm Dr., or Lucas Ave.

Families can drop off all children at one door with the older sibling entering with the younger sibling(s) if needed.

Please use caution and follow all traffic laws to ensure students are safe during drop-off and pick-up times.



SAFE ARRIVAL / TRANSPORTATION

Please note that all students who are not in attendance at school during any given day are part of the school-wide call back system. Teachers report the names of children who are absent and if the parent of the absent child has not called the Safe Arrival Call-in System at 1-855-278-4513 to report their absence, they will be notified by phone regarding their child/ren absence by an automated system. In order to ensure the safety of our students, it is imperative that parents/guardians notify the school of any absences or late arrivals. Students who arrive at school late are instructed to report to the office first before going to their classroom.

If your child is bussed to school, please call your bus provider as soon as possible at 204-586-8800 (opens at 6:30 a.m.) You can also call Transportation Department at 204-789-0452 or Wheelchair Services at 204-982-0799.

Should your child/ren need to leave the school early for any reason, please send a note to the teacher with the date and time of departure. Please indicate who will be picking up your child. An adult is required to sign your child out in the office before leaving the school.

Prairie Rose School offers Lunch Program for Grades 1 - 6 students at no cost. Lunch Program runs from 12:00 to 12:55 p.m. Children are expected to bring a healthy bagged lunch every day and note that microwave service is not provided. Please ensure all items are labeled with your child's name and room number.

Grades 1–6 students are supervised throughout the 12:00–12:55 p.m. lunch period. Students eat lunch from 12:00 to approximately 12:30 p.m., after which they are supervised on the playground, weather permitting, or dismissed to noon-hour clubs. During inclement weather, students will participate in supervised indoor activities.

Each year, September 30 marks the **National Day for Truth and Reconciliation**. The day honours the children who never returned home and Survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities. Public commemoration of the tragic and painful history and ongoing impacts of residential schools is a vital component of the reconciliation process. Both the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation and Orange Shirt Day take place on September 30.

Orange Shirt Day is an Indigenous-led grassroots commemorative day intended to raise awareness of the individual, family and community inter-generational impacts of residential schools, and to promote the concept of “Every Child Matters”. The orange shirt is a symbol of the stripping away of culture, freedom and self-esteem experienced by Indigenous children over generations.

Dear Families,

We are excited to share that the Manitoba government is introducing free transit for youth across the province and is partnering with the City of Winnipeg to provide the service. Students can access passes through their school as part of a staged roll-out beginning the first week of the 2026/27 school year.

School divisions are working closely with Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning to ensure that all eligible youth can access bus passes through their school. Passes will be distributed to students in grades 6 to 12 in the following stages:

- September 8, 2026: Grades 11 and 12
- September 23, 2026: Grades 9 and 10
- September 29, 2026: Grades 6, 7 and 8

If a student needs a transit pass sooner than their grade eligibility, families can speak to school administration so that a pass can be made available for the student. We ask that you emphasize the importance of keeping the pass safe and not losing or damaging it.

Passes are valid for a full year and will expire on August 31, 2027. Passes issued to students are not transferable and are for the student's use only. Students in grades 10 to 12 are encouraged to carry their student ID together with their pass.

As per current Winnipeg Transit policy, children aged 11 and under can ride free when accompanied by a fare-paying customer.

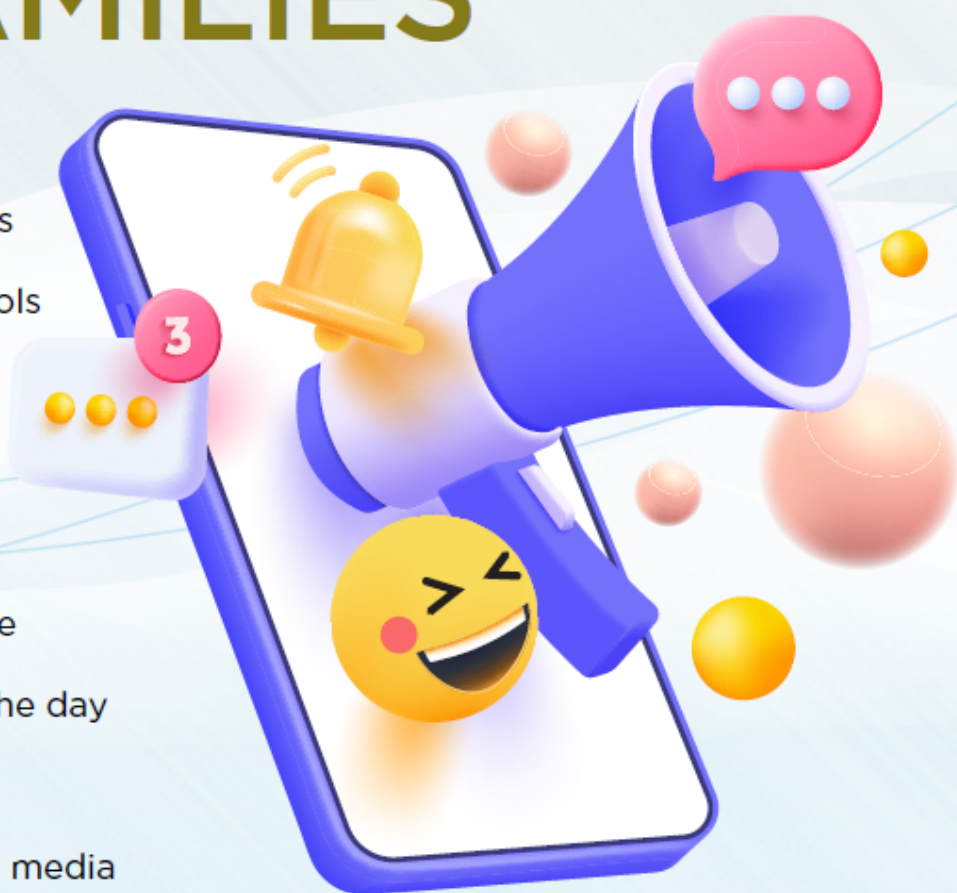

CELL PHONE TIPS FOR FAMILIES

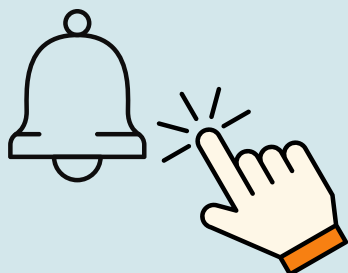
- Turn off screens and remove them from bedrooms 30 to 60 minutes before bedtime
- Learn about parental controls
- Provide clear limits
- Designate some times and places as no-device zones
- Maximize in-person activity and sleep, rather than focusing on total screen hours
- Provide experiences outside with other children
- Provide clear structure to the day and week
- Look for signs of addiction and problematic use
- Delay the opening of social media accounts until 16
- Coordinate with other families to create community expectations
- Talk with your child about the risks, and listen to their thoughts
- Talk to your child's teacher and principal and support the new provincial direction on mobile devices

Security Cameras in Schools



Keeping our students, staff, parents and visitors safe in Winnipeg School Division schools is a top priority. One way we do this is by monitoring areas in schools (eg. entrances, hallways and school buses) using security cameras.

Security cameras are used to monitor WSD property to assist in detecting and deterring unacceptable behavior or activities, and to assist investigations when required. WSD has put in place a detailed policy about the collection, use, protection, retention and/or disclosure of information captured on security cameras with the provisions of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Personal Privacy Act (FIPPA), the Personal Health Information Act (PHIA), the Youth Criminal Justice Act, as well as WSD Policy EGC – Records Management and Retention.

NORWEST DAYCARE

NorWest's Early Learning Childcare Centre is a non-profit child care centre licensed through Manitoba Early Learning and Child Care. We have been in operation for more than 40 years. We have two sites: our Lucas Ave location is licensed to accept 66 children aged 1-12 years (4 infant, 32 preschool and 30 school age) and our Keewatin location is licensed to accept 12 infants (age 3 months to 24 months). Both sites are open throughout the week from 7:00 am – 5:00 pm except statutory holidays.

We recognize each child as an individual with different interests, strengths, and levels of development. Our team of certified Early Childhood Educators and assistants deliver age-appropriate activities aimed to enhance a child's social, emotional and physical development. We also help your child build strong cognitive, language, motor, and self-help skills.

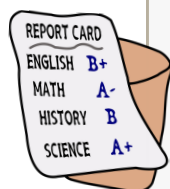
