Garbage / Recycling:

The City of Winnipeg provides special services to residents living in their own homes that are physically unable to put out their own garbage & recycling. This service is called **Walk-up Collection Services**. There is no additional fee for this service.

Who is Eligible for this Service?

Available to residents who are functionally unable to get their recycling and garbage carts to the curb or lane and have no one in the house who can do this.

How do I receive the Walk-up Collection Service?

To apply, please call **311** to have an application form mailed to you or download the Walk-up Collection Service Application form from <https://winnipeg.ca/waterandwaste/pdfs/ApplicationforWalk-upService2017.pdf>. You will need a health care professional to sign your initial application. You need to reapply for this service each year.

“Like education, healthcare also needs to be given importance”

Students will study:

- The structure and function of the human body
- Common diseases and conditions
- Infection control
- Medical Language
- Enhancing knowledge of client well-being
- Developing practical skills in preparation for practicum

Approx. 460 hours will be spent in the clinical setting, gaining experience by working alongside other health care aides and functioning as a part of the health care team in hospitals and personal care homes.



Upon successful completion

Students will be certified health care aides and get employment in hospitals, personal care homes and within the community.

The employment prospects are excellent, and there are a variety of full-time, part-time and casual positions available in numerous settings.



Health Care Aide Program

This is a *ten-month, full-time* program (September-June) that prepares students to work as health care aides in hospitals, long term care facilities and is a recognized training program by the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority (WHRA) & Shared Health.

Women of Millwrighting

In-demand trade, strong career growth, hands-on work

WHAT: 19-week introductory millwrighting program that provides an entry-level pathway into the millwrighting industry.

WHEN: May 25, 2026 - October 2, 2026

WHO: Preference will be given to unemployed and underemployed First Nations members through the FPD ISET communities in Manitoba who hold a valid Class 5 driver's license.

WHERE: 130 Henlaw Bay (Manitoba Institute of Trades and Technology) Winnipeg, Manitoba

PREREQUISITES: Grade 12 or equivalent, 18 years of age, must be committed to participate in the 19-week program.

*Eligible applicants must not have participated in previous FPD programs.
