## Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures

Please bring your child to their classroom entry point where they will meet their teacher. Teachers will be outside to direct students to their lines.

Rooms 8, 11, 12, 13, 16, and 17 will line up and meet their teacher at the doors by the little play structure (Warsaw street side of the building).

Rooms 21, 22, 23, and 26 will line up and meet their teacher at the doors by the garden/big play structure/parking lot (Jessie street side of the building).

Please do not arrive prior to 8:15 a.m., We do not have outdoor supervision for students (other than students arriving on the bus) prior to that time.

At the end of the day, 3:00pm, students will be dismissed from their same entry doors. If you are picking up your child, please meet them there.

If you need to pick your child up early, please inform the office and classroom teacher. We will have them ready for the requested time.



For safety reasons, doors to the building will remain locked. This does not mean that parents/guardians are not allowed in. If you want/need to enter the building please come to the front entrance and press the bell/buzzer. Office staff will verify who you are and let in the building.

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
