Drop Off and Pick Up - Parents/Guardians please be reminded that students are to arrive at school for 8:55 and be picked up at 12:00. They are to enter and leave from the back doors of the school. They are to be dropped off at 12:55 and picked up at 3:30. If you need to pick your child up early, please report to the office and office staff will call your child down. If your child is under 7 years of age, you must meet your child's teacher at the back doors for a handoff/person to person exchange.

Lunch Program – At this time there is no fee for lunch program. However, the lunch program is for students whose guardians live more than a kilometer away or are not home during the lunch hours. We realize that there may also may be extenuating circumstances. Lunch applications will be reviewed on case by case basis. If you wish for your child to be in the lunch program please fill out an application at the office or one can be sent home with your child.


