Dear Parents/Guardians and students,

As you are well aware, the costs of undertaking a graduation celebration dinner and SafeGrad are extensive. Collège Churchill High School has a long tradition of engaging in fundraising activities to offset the costs to the students and families who wish to be a part of this very significant event.
