We do books, we do puzzles and games, we chat! St. John's library comes on **Fridays** for stories and songs!

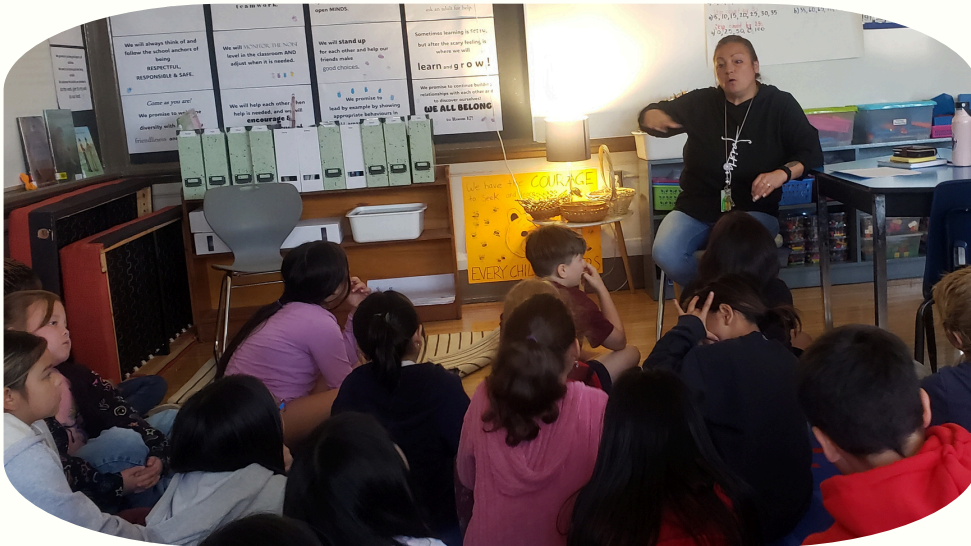

Students are put into small groups and given a challenge to complete in a set amount of time with the same materials.

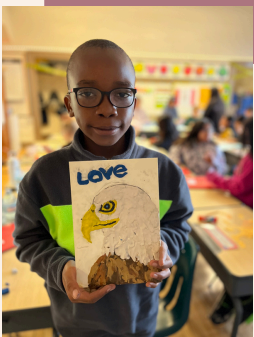
It practices collaboration, communication, critical thinking and creativity.
