DESCRIPTION OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

Allan Simpson Memorial Scholarship - awarded to a student with exceptional needs and a future learning plan; has adequate academics, shows perseverance and determination and is involved in extra-curricular activities and /or community.

Andre Doumbe High School Graduate Award - Awarded to a graduate enrolled at a University or College, of African decent and who volunteers, participates and gets involved in his/her community.

Captain Barry Leipsic Awards - established in memory of a former Gordon Bell student, and is presented to students with integrity and honour who also go out of their way to help and support others.

Champion Ironworks Scholarships - recognizes top academics and leadership at our Fresh Start and Senior Off-Campus programs.

Child Guidance Clinic Award of Merit - given to a student who has shown resilience and determination in the face of adversity.

Children of My Heart Award - was established in honour of the late Leuba Franko, who was an English teacher of literature and a published author and given to a 1st or 2nd generation Canadian who aspires to become a teacher.

Chown Centennial Entrance Scholarship - given to an "all-around" graduating student enrolling in the University of Manitoba, with a minimum of 85%.

Daniel McIntyre Councillor's Award - recognizes an individual who has shown outstanding engagement in their school and community. It is awarded to a students who is reliable, trustworthy and a good citizen.

Dhuq'Mar Awards - Two awards for students in their last year at Gordon Bell to support their creative life-giving plans, intended to help students overcome barriers to success.

Dr. Alex Wilson Memorial Scholarship from Ma Mawi Wi Chi Itata Centre Children's Legacy Fund Scholarship is awarded to an Indigenous student each year at a different high school in Winnipeg pursuing post-secondary education. This student shares the values and beliefs held by Dr. Alex Wilson.

Dr. C.T. Ethans Memorial Scholarship - established in memory of a former Gordon Bell student. It is awarded to a graduate who demonstrated academic excellence, has been involved in their community and who is interested in pursuing a career in medicine.

Governor General's Medal - honours top scholastic achievement in both grades 11 and 12 and is the most prestigious award a Canadian student can receive.

Gordon Bell Purple and Gold Award - award was established by the Gordon Bell Scholarship Committee to recognize the graduate's contributions to the school community.

Herb Lother Memorial Award - awarded to a student who has shown academic growth and perseverance, participation in school and/or community activities and pursuing post secondary education.

Indigenous Leadership Development Institute Inc. Scholarship Award- given to an Indigenous student who displays excellent leadership and will attend a post secondary institution.

James Duncan Memorial Music Award - awarded to a student involved extensively in the music program.

John M. Vail Scholarship - awarded to a student with outstanding academic achievement, who excels in math and science, emphasizing physics and is pursuing studies in the Faculty of Science at the University of Manitoba.

Judith Dueck New Canadian Award - created in honour of a former Gordon Bell teacher librarian. This award is presented to a new Canadian who has demonstrated determination, who has the ability to achieve personal goals and who will attend a post secondary institution.

Judy Stewart Sutherland Scholarship - presented to a student with outstanding academic achievement, who has a minimum average of 80% on the best grade twelve courses, active in sports and pursuing engineering or science at the University of Manitoba.

Leadership in Social Justice Achievement Scholarships - award to students who are actively involved within the school community or the broader community.

Lions Club of Winnipeg Scholarship - presented to a students who has overcome language barriers and who is pursuing post-secondary education.

Macdonald/Cageorge Citizenship Award - presented to a student who has a good academic standing, with a focus on being involved in the community and who participates in extra-curricular activities.

Pattison Outdoor Advertising Awards -this award was established in 2012, as a way to honour exceptional students from Gordon Bell High School.

Peaceful Village Awards - presented to graduating students who attended Peaceful Village during their years at Gordon Bell High School.

Peter Pura Memorial Award - awarded to a graduating Gordon Bell student intending to study Math, Computer Science, or another area of Science, who demonstrates determination, dedication and hard work.

Schulich Leader Scholarships is a Canadian undergraduate award program that provides scholarships for students who demonstrate excellence in academics, leadership, charisma, and creativity, and are enrolled in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) areas of study. It is one of the most prestigious scholarships in Canada.

Souchay Gossen Foundation Scholarship - awarded to a student who demonstrates commitment to education, is involved in the school and / or community and who is planning to attend a post-secondary institution in the future.

Souchay Gossen Welcome Hand Scholarship - awarded to a student who is not born in Canada, demonstrates dedication to education, is engaged in the community outside of school and who plans to attend a post-secondary institution in the future.

The Kwan Family Merit Scholarships - Established in 2022 in honour of their parents, Man Tin and Shou King, and named for the Kwan children, Jean, Tom, Susan, Judy, Wendy and Archie who attended and graduated from Gordon Bell from 1971-1986. This award is presented to 2 well-deserving graduates who have experienced hardships in their lives, but in spite of this, were still able to excel academically. The students have an average of 80% or higher and will be pursuing post-secondary studies.

Victor P. Thiessen Memorial Award - awarded to a deserving graduating student who has exhibited significant personal and academic improvement over the course of senior high and whose persistence and determination has allowed them to graduate.

Western Communities Foundation Inspirational Award - presented to a graduating student who displays outstanding community and school spirit and has overcome hardships and adversity.

Winnipeg School Board Book Awards - awarded by the Winnipeg School Division to honour academic integrity.

Winnipeg School Board Post Secondary Scholarship - awarded to a student who has achieved a high academic standing and is pursuing post secondary education.

Winnipeg Teachers' Association (WTA) High School Scholarship - presented to a student for outstanding citizenship and who will pursue post-secondary education.

Young United Church Bursaries- acknowledges achievements, perseverance and character of a Main Campus and Senior Off-Campus graduate.
