- School bus transportation is free.
- An adult <u>must</u> be present at drop-off for the driver to let the students off the bus. The adult <u>must</u> be a legal contact on the student's pick up/drop off list at the school.

Deadline for bus requests for the 2023-2024 school year is Friday, March 17, 2023.
