### New registrations for the 2025/2026 school year

Was your child born in 2021? – if yes, they are eligible for the Nursery Program  
Was your child born in 2020? – if yes, they are eligible for our Kindergarten program

We are also accepting new registrations for students in grade 1-6

If your child is currently enrolled at LNS, you do not need to register them again

#### **IMPORTANT:**

Catchment school registration is open for new students. **All students must register with their catchment schools first.** If your child is returning to their current school, there is no need to register. School of Choice applications are open for within-division students and outside-division students. Grade 6 students must register at their catchment school first.

#### **May 15**

School of Choice applications close.
