If you returned your STUDENT INTENTION form with a Nursery or Kindergarten child named, our office has sent a registration package home with your child. Please complete it and return it to the office as soon as possible. In order to determine the number of Nursery and Kindergarten classes, we would appreciate registrations as soon as possible.

As the weather gets warmer, please encourage your children to get outside and play in the fresh air and sunlight! It is great for our minds and bodies.

The last day of class before Spring Break is Friday, March 22nd and classes will resume on Monday, April 1st.
