# New registrations for the 2025/2026 school year

## **IMPORTANT DATES:**

Catchment school registration is open for new students. All students must register with their catchment schools first. If your child is returning to their current school, there is no need to register. Online registration opens at 9:00 a.m.

#### March 3

School of Choice applications open for within-division students and outside-division students. Online applications open at 9:00 a.m.

## May 15

School of Choice applications close.

To determine the school that serves your home address, use our Find a School tool on the WSD1 website. Search your street name and click on the map to see your child's early, middle or senior years schools, as well as schools your child can attend for WSD language programs.

You can register online by visiting <u>www.winnipegsd.ca</u> and clicking on student registration. The link will open February 10 at 9:00 a.m.
