Happy November to all of our families!

Language is the single best predictor of school achievement. The key to strong language skills are those back-and-forth fluent conversations between young children and their caregivers. Talking and listening to children does a lot of important things. It improves your bond with them, and encourages them to listen to you. It helps them to form relationships and to build self-esteem. It also teaches important turn-taking skills. Keep the art of conversation alive between you and your children by saying, "tell me about the best part of your day!" You will be surprised at all the great conversations you can have.

Parent/Teacher Conferences are scheduled for Thursday, November 21 (evening) and Friday, November 28 (morning). To make the process easier, we will be using the on-line booking system, *SchoolInterviews*, to input your preferred meeting time with your child(ren)'s teacher. The link for *SchoolInterviews* will be sent to all families on Wednesday, November 6<sup>th</sup>. Please ensure you book with the correct teacher.

Report cards will be issued on November 27<sup>th</sup> after conferences have been held. The rationale for the change, is our desire to spend time talking about the whole child as a learner. The report card is a snapshot of where your child(ren) current achievement is in a primarily academic domain (Math, Language Arts, Science etc.). We would like to invite you to join us in celebrating the strengths, challenges and next steps of our learners as it pertains to their academic AND social-emotional well-being. We would also love for you to share any insights or ask questions to help support us working together to improve the academic and social-emotional well-being of our children.

Starting November 1st, 2024, the cost of the Lunch Program will be reduced to \$20 per month for the first child in your household. Additional children in the household will be \$5. We believe this pricing structure will make it more affordable for families. This reduction is made possible with support from the Winnipeg School Division's increase in hours for Educational Assistants to support supervision over the lunch hour. If you are home during lunch hours, your child has the option to go home for lunch or to participate in the program by paying the specified fees. We want to assure you that we are actively working towards establishing a free lunch program in the future.
