



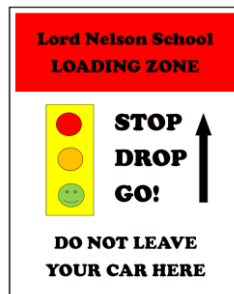
Welcome back to a new school year! We have a great team of educators who are excited to work with you and your children so that they learn and grow to their highest potential. If you have questions about your child's learning platform, please connect with their classroom teacher for information. You can see this information on our website under the Academics and Classes tab. Part of our school protocol is practicing safety procedures. We will have fire, evacuation, tornado and lockdown drills to ensure everyone's safety in the case of an emergency.

On Thursday, September 28th, Lord Nelson School will gather to commemorate and continue our journey towards reconciliation. Friday, September 29th will be a day that students and staff are encouraged to show their solidarity and empathy by wearing an orange shirt to honour the survivors of Residential Schools for Orange Shirt Day on Saturday, September 30th.

During the school year, we will be closed for 10 days for administrative purposes and to continue our professional development as a staff. These are always listed on our calendars and on our website.

For the **safety** of all students, please help your children to follow these expectations:

- Arrive at school **AFTER 8:45 am** when there is school supervision
- All students who are being picked up are asked to exit at their entry/exit door
- Afternoon arrivals – If your children go home for lunch please remind them to return at 12:50 p.m. and wait at their regular entry/exit door
- Pick-up your children promptly at **3:25 pm**. In the event that you require someone (other than those listed on your child's student information form) to pick up your child, you must call the office and let us know.
- Parents/guardians are asked to **drop students off by the hole in the fence on Aberdeen by the STOP, DROP and GO sign**; they should **exit the car on the curb side** and cross the sidewalk through the path at the fence and go directly onto the playground
- Students walking from the Redwood Street side are asked to walk to the corner and cross with crossing guards. Please do not allow your children to jay-walk
- **PLEASE DO NOT** stop/drop off or expect your child to meet you in the NO STOPPING zone on Redwood Avenue or in the staff parking lot. Parking Authority are ticketing parked or stopped cars.



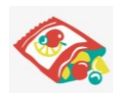
CHILD CARE

If you require supervision for your child before 8:45 am or after 3:25 pm, we offer a YMCA/YWCA Before and After School Program and a Nursery/Kinder Care Program. It is located in the lower gym and is open from 7-8:50 am and 3:25-6 pm for the Before and After Program. The Nursery/KinderCare Program is open opposite our N/K class. Student Absences – School Messenger

Our school uses the School Messenger program for parents/guardians to report their child's absence. There are 3 options available for you to report their absence or late arrival.

If your child will be absent/late, please either:

1. Call 1-855-278-4513 and follow the prompts. You must wait for a confirmation number, if you hang up too soon the absence will not be recorded.
2. Visit go.schoolmessenger.ca (please ensure you are using .ca and not .com site)
3. Download the SchoolMessenger app (free) (blue colored)

If you do not report your child's absence the automated notification system will contact parents at multiple contact numbers until one of the designated contacts is reached.

If you receive a call from Safe Arrival, do not hang up and call the school. Listen to the message and enter the reason for your child's absence, at the end you will receive a confirmation number. The school will be notified of the absence.



Late Arrivals

If your child arrives late to school (either in the morning or after lunch) they **MUST** report to the office. Your child will be given a late slip to hand into their teacher. If your child does not check in at the office you will receive a call from the automated notification system informing you of your child's absence.
