WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL!

We are so excited to welcome back all students to school as well as meet some new ones! We have prepared these slides to help answer some of the questions you may have for your child to have a successful start to the school year.

An email will be sent out every Friday to parents/guardians with our WAG ("week at a glance") so you can see what's on the calendar for the following week as well as any need to know information, so you are up to date on a regular basis.

If you child arrives late to school, they must report to the office upon arrival. If you are picking them up early, please report to the office to sign them out. It is also important for students to stay at home if they are sick and not return to school until they are well. If students present with consistent/ongoing or increasing signs of illness at school (cough, sore throat, runny nose, vomiting, etc.) that is not typical of them, then they will be sent home.

Parents/guardians are expected to pick them up in a reasonable time if contacted due to illness.

Entry/Arrival and Exit/Dismissal

Morning arrival/line-up 8:50

Dismissal 3:25

Teachers will greet their students outside daily in a specific line-up area as well a take them back to the same area to be picked-up outside at the end of the day.

Rooms 2, 4, 5, 6, 11

Line-up on the entrance way in front of the main school doors on Beresford Avenue

Room 21, 23, 24, 26, 28, 31

Line-up on the pavement at the large playground area by the East side doors of the building

*Students should not arrive <u>unaccompanied</u> at school before the 8:50 line-up time as there is no supervision prior to the school day

*Students who are bussed to school will be greeted by staff in the bus loop at their set arrival times

Nursery & Kindergarten Start to the Year & Line-Up

All families of nursery & kindergarten students will have the opportunity to book an appointment to meet their teacher one on one. Appointments will be on either September 3, 4, or 5, and a link for booking a time will be sent by email. All nursery and kindergarten students will have their first official full day of class/school on Monday, September 8th.

Drop-off and pick-up will be outside the courtyard gate on the west side of the building beside the parking lot. Parking in the lot <u>is not</u> open to the public, unassigned cars will be towed.

Morning class: drop-off 8:50 pick-up 11:20

Afternoon class: drop-off 12:50 pick-up 3:20

Breakfast Program & Snack Times

8:30-8:50 10:35 and 12:50

Breakfast Program:

The Breakfast Program will begin on Monday, September 8th and run daily during school days starting at 8:30am. It is complementary and all students are welcome.

Snack/Movement Breaks (Grade 1-6):

School staff supervise all breaks. The first snack/outdoor movement break is from 10:35-11:10 daily. The second snack/outdoor movement break is from 12:50-1:45 daily. Students in daycare will eat at daycare/be supervised by daycare during the second break. As the second break is longer, families wanting any student to go home from 12:50-1:45 need to let teachers know. Afternoon attendance will occur right after the second break.

The school also provides school wide snack a couple days a week and complimentary milk daily during the second break.

PATROLS

Student patrols go on duty at the start and end of the school day (approximately 8:40 and 3:20).

Patrols also go on duty at the start and end of the second snack/movement break of the day as families may choose to have students go home during that break. Approximately 12:45 and 1:35.

Visitors, Appointments, Late Arrivals & Early Pick-Ups

It is important for families to call SAFE ARRIVAL (1-855-278-4513) anytime their child will be absent or arrive late for any reason. Should anyone arrive late they are to enter through the front main doors on Beresford and immediately report to the office. You can also access Safe Arrival at go.schoolmessenger.ca

Please call the office at 204-453-6639 and let us know if your child/children need to be picked up early so we can have them ready or for any inquiries. You can also email the school at lordroberts@wsd1.org for any inquiries or further attendance needs.

Once you arrive, please enter through the main front door and head to the office where a staff member will ensure your child/children safely meet you to depart.

If you have an appointment with a teacher or administrator, please enter through the main front doors and report to the office.

All visitors are to report to the office upon entry. Please, no congregating in hallways or roaming the building as this is a distraction to teaching and learning as well as a safety concern. If you have items to drop off for your child, please bring them to the office and we will assist you.

If you would like to see the principal making an appointment in advance is appreciated as a drop in visit is not alway possible.
