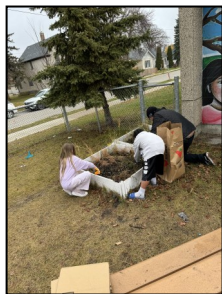

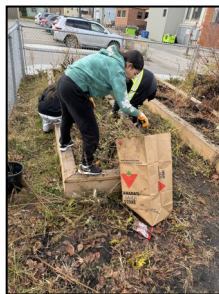
ROOTS AND SHOOTS NEWS

This is A LOT of fun and everything looks so TIDY!



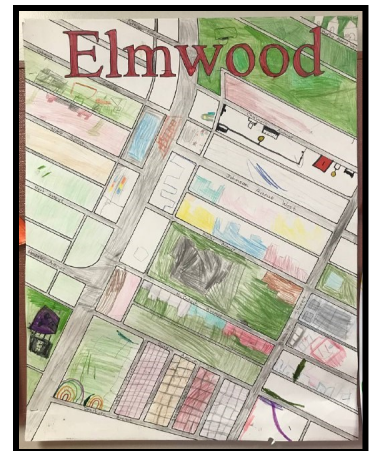
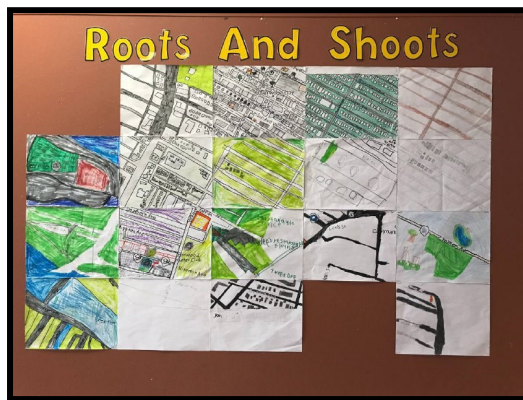
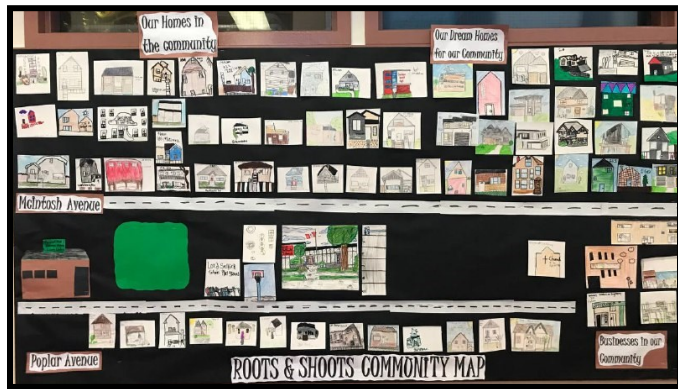
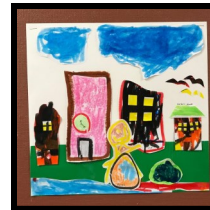
