NURSERY: CHILD MUST BE 4 YEARS OLD BEFORE DEC. 31, 2025 KINDERGARTEN: CHILD MUST BE 5 YEARS OLD BEFORE DEC.31, 2025

NURSERY PROGRAM IS **FREE** TO ALL RESIDENTS OF THE WINNIPEG SCHOOL DIVISION. RESIDENCY IS BASED ON WHERE THE LEGAL GUARDIAN RESIDES.

IF YOUR CHILD IS PRESENTLY IN NURSERY IN OUR SCHOOL THERE IS NO NEED TO RE-REGISTER FOR KINDERGARTEN. BOTH PROGRAMS ARE HALF DAY PROGRAMS.
