Dear Principal Sparling Community,

As we have reached the halfway point in the school year, I want to remind families about some of the school routines and programs that are in place, to ensure student safety.

Breakfast Program

Open to enter from 8:30 – 8:45. After eating breakfast, students will be asked to go outside to line up with their class.

Morning Arrival and Line Up Location

All students (who do not attend Harstone Children's Centre) **should line up with their classroom, outside of the school. Students will enter with their teacher at 8:55am.** Only students who are attending breakfast program will be permitted to enter the school earlier than 8:55.

Rooms 8,11 &12 line up directly in front of the main school staircase/doors.

Rooms 7, 9, 15 &19 line up at the north side of the school, by the gym doors.

Lunch Program/Lunch Hour

All students who are registered for the lunch program must report to the lunchroom every day. Attendance is taken daily. Students are not permitted to leave the school during the lunch hour unless we have received permission from the parent/guardian. **Students who go home for lunch should not be returning to the school prior to 12:55 and need to line up outside in their classroom line up spot.**

End of Day Dismissal

Students will be dismissed from school, by their teacher at 3:30. They will be dismissed from the same doors that they enter into, in the morning.

Patrol Duty Times

Patrols should report to school no earlier than 8:45 and 12:45, for the weeks they are on patrol.
