Welcome Back

Welcome to the 2023-2024 school year! We are very excited to start the school year with an **Open House/Meet the Teacher** on Tuesday, September 5th from 3:00pm – 5:00pm. Families are welcome to tour the school and visit with all staff during this time. Classroom teachers will be in their rooms to greet families and provide an opportunity for students to drop off all their school supplies.

On Wednesday, September 6^{th} , classes will begin for all grades 1-6 students. Nursery/Kindergarten students will be scheduled for an individual meeting time with the classroom teacher on either September 5^{th} or 6^{th} , then have a staggered start (shortened morning) on Friday, September 8^{th} , followed by regular classes on Monday, September 11^{th} .

Please find the highlights of the Queenston School protocol below. Although we have planned extensively, situations may arise that may require a change or an adjustment. If you encounter a concern or have any questions or comments, please feel free to contact the school. Your feedback is appreciated!

Student Drop Off and Pick Up

All parents are encouraged to drop off/pick up their child at the specified times. Adult supervision is available on the playground at 8:45 am - 9:00 am and 12:50 pm - 12:55 pm.

School entry/exit times:

If your child arrives late or needs to be dismissed earlier, please input the information on SAFE ARRIVAL and contact the school so that we ensure all students enter and exit school safely.

Bikes/Scooters/Skateboards

Students are welcome to ride their bikes, scooters and/or skateboards to school. However, once they arrive at school, these items need to be promptly secured with a lock outside on the racks provided. There is not enough storage space in the school for students to bring these items inside.

Student Entrance/Exit Locations

All classrooms have been assigned a specified entrance and exit location. The classroom teachers will greet students at this location at entrance times and escort students to this location at dismissal times.

^{*}Please note that all doors will be locked during the day (except for entrance times and recess times), as per Winnipeg School Division Safe Schools Recommendation. If you require access during the day, please use main door (Sheilah Sweatman) on Queenston Street and use the intercom to contact the office.

Recess

There will be a whole school (grades 1-6) recess in the morning (10:40 am) and afternoon (2:35 pm). Students are able to play in the location of their choice.

Please note that food/snacks are not permitted on the playground. Each classroom teacher will provide an opportunity for students to have a snack in the classroom, where students can safely be monitored.

Lunch Program

The lunch program is a QSAC initiative. All grade 1-6 students will be eating in the multipurpose room from 12:00 pm - 12:25 pm and then enjoy time outdoors from 12:25 pm - 12:55 pm.

Safe Arrival Program

Safe Arrival is an absent reporting system that helps ensure all students arrive at school safely. Please ensure you have created a profile, as all student absences, early dismissals and late arrivals must be reported through this system.

With **SafeArrival**, you are asked to report your child's absence in advance using any of these 3 convenient methods:

- Using your mobile device, download and install the SchoolMessenger app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at https://go.schoolmessenger.ca). The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
- Use the SafeArrival website, https://go.schoolmessenger.ca. The first time you use the website, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.
