## École Riverview School Balanced School Day

École Riverview School will be moving to a balanced school day model in September. A balanced school day represents an adjustment to how recess and nutrition breaks are distributed throughout the school day. The actual length of the school day remains the same but time within the day is "balanced" between two nutrition/activity breaks. The balanced schedule increases instructional time by reducing time lost during transitions. A balanced schedule allows for longer periods of time for students to eat and be active. With two scheduled nutrition breaks, families can plan for snacks/lunches that are nutritious, rather than focusing on snacks that are quick and convenient. Parents are encouraged to pack food separately so students know which food they should eat at each of the breaks and to ensure they have sufficient food for the day.

Some of the benefits of a Balanced School Day are:

- Maximize instructional time throughout the day due to fewer interruptions and transitions.
- Less conflicts due to transitions.
- More time to solve conflicts during longer recess
- Making time for good nutrition promotes good learning
- More time on task, longer work periods allow for more project-based learning.
- Children are not as hungry at the end of the day
