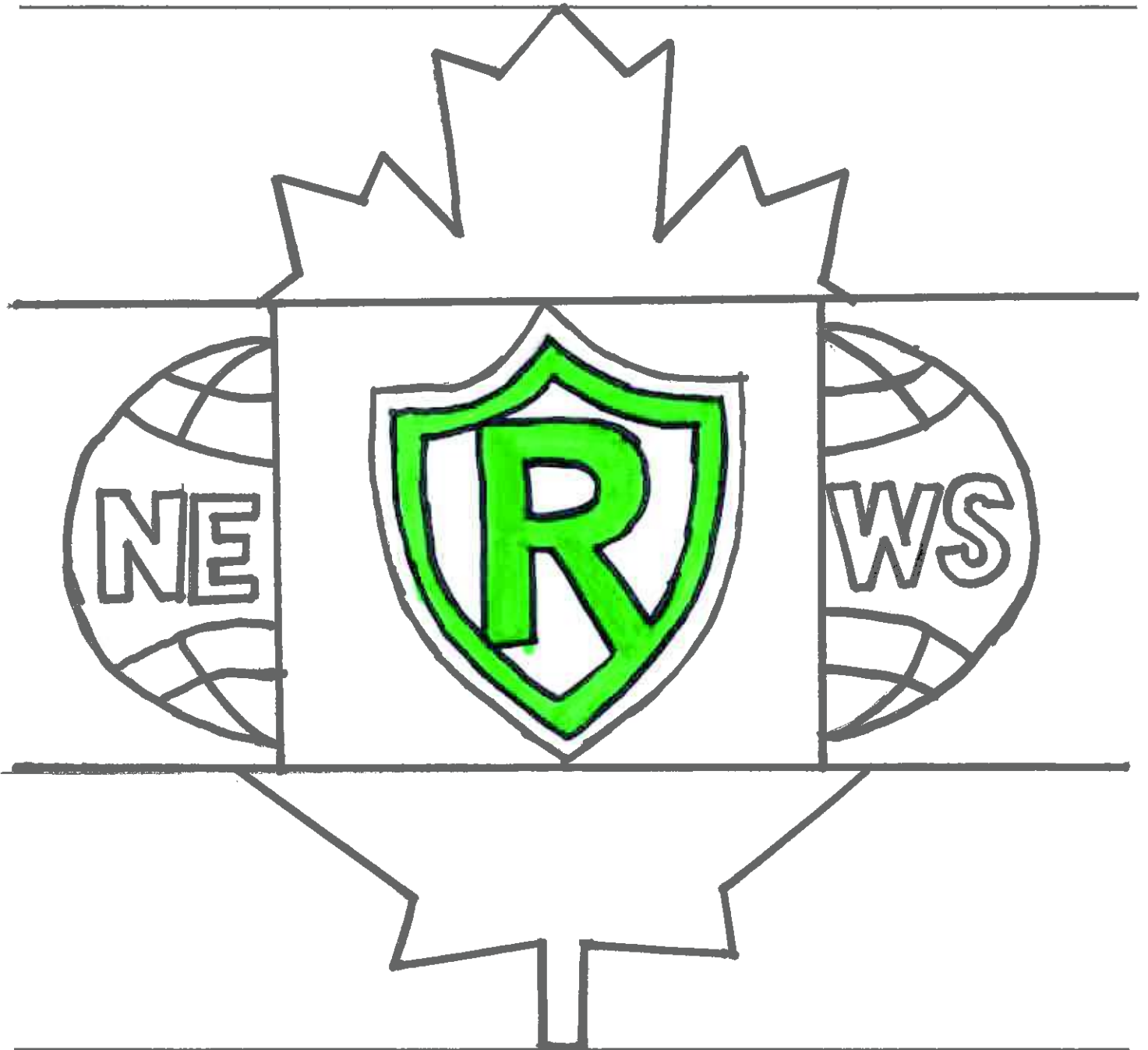

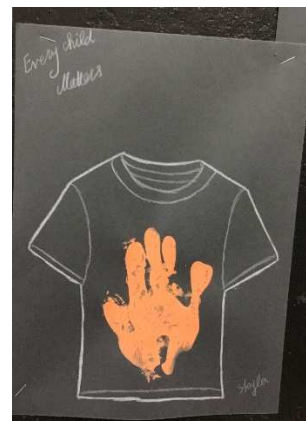

Skyla takes an enthusiastic approach as she gets called on

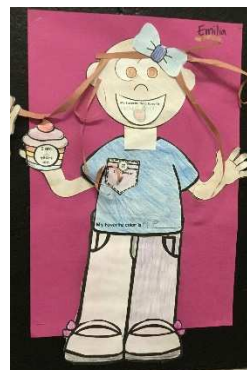
Hi! My name is Norah! I interviewed Skyla, Emilia, and Emma. I am going to do an entertaining few sentences about each artist.

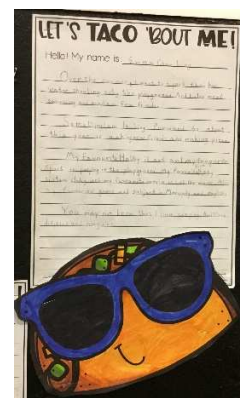
Emelia explains her artwork, grinning the whole time

Courage means if you have the gut to do a thing your scared of.

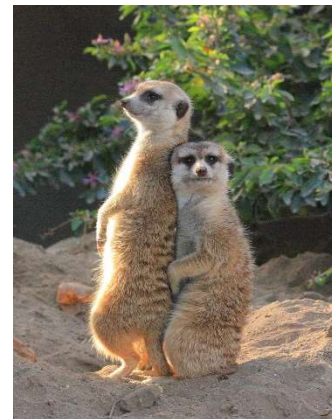

Hurricane Ian

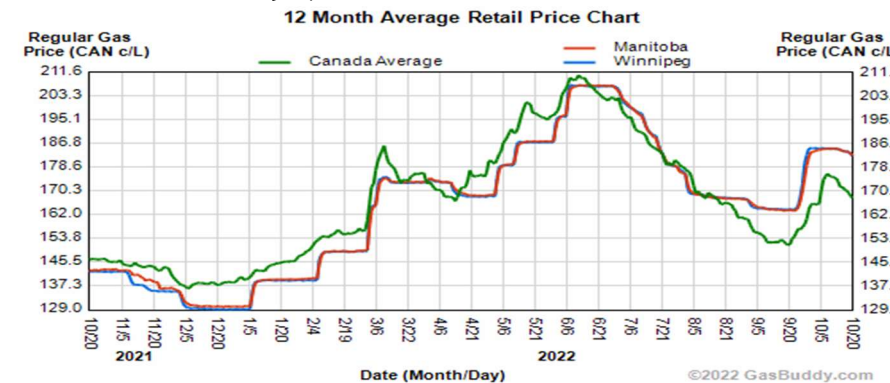
