**Dear Sister MacNamara Families,** 

Welcome to the month of December. Our first term was full of wonderful events and a great deal of joyful learning. We thank all of our families who connected with teachers to celebrate student learning and to make plans for next steps. If you were not able to meet with your child's teacher in person or by phone, please call them to set up an appointment time to celebrate your child's learning.

Reminder: As the temperatures are getting colder, please do not send your children to school before 8:45 A.M. and 12:50 P.M. Pickups need to be at 12:00 P.M. and 3:30 P.M. sharp. If you are picking up children in a vehicle please remember to use Deacon Street safely—pull to the side of the road, stop and wait. This is a no idle zone. Everyone needs to do their part in keeping the area a safe place for students and families at dismissal times. It is important to ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the weather. Students go outside for recess and sometimes during Phys. Ed. classes. If you need support in this area, please let us know. We do have a supply of mitts, hats and scarves for children to use when needed. We can connect you with Koats for Kids for other needs.
