Happy October! There has been much excitement and energy as we welcomed students and their families back to Sister MacNamara School. Please check for updated information on our school website and notes that come home from your child's teacher.

These are but a few of the highlights of the school year so far:

Our Safe Arrival Attendance System is working well. Please remember to report absences, late arrivals or early departures on the Safe Arrival System before 9:00 AM.

- The Welcome to Kindergarten evening will be held on Thursday, October 6th at 5:00 PM.
- Lunch Program payments are due at the beginning of each month and can be made during office hours.
- Individual school pictures will be taken by Life Touch Photo Company on Thursday, October 13th.
- Halloween celebrations are up to the classroom teachers and information will follow.
- Playground safety is very important. Families returning with their child at noon must wait at the picnic area, and not on the field/play structure as this space is for our students in the Lunch Program.

School arrival time in the morning is 8:50 and at lunch 12:55. Dismissal is at 3:30. Please ensure you are picking up your child/children promptly at noon and 3:30.

- Our K - 6 teachers have begun to assess their students using the Winnipeg School Division's Elementary Assessment Program. Teachers have this opportunity to get to know each of their students' learning strengths. This will help to plan for your children's learning success.

If you fill it in, please phone the school to make an appointment to bring your child's ID in to the office. You are also welcome to call the school or come to the school to register.

SAFE ARRIVAL

Dear Parents/Guardians,

At Winnipeg School Division, one of our greatest priorities is ensuring that all our students arrive safely at school each and every day.

To enhance our existing absence-checking procedure, we are introducing *a more efficient* student absence reporting system called **SafeArrival**. This system will reduce the time it takes to verify student attendance, make it easy for you to report your child's absence and easy for staff to respond to unexplained student absences.

With **SafeArrival**, you are asked to report your child's absence in advance using any of these 3 convenient methods:

Using your mobile device, download and install the **SchoolMessenger app** from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at <https://go.schoolmessenger.ca>). The first time you use the app, select **Sign Up** to create your account. Select **Attendance** then **Report an Absence**.

Use the SafeArrival website, <https://go.schoolmessenger.ca>. The first time you use the website, select **Sign Up** to create your account. Select **Attendance** then **Report an Absence**.

Call the toll-free number **1-855-278-4513** to report an absence using the automated phone system.

These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week. Future absences can be reported at any time.

Starting **Wednesday, September 7, 2022**, please report absences in advance using **SafeArrival** instead of sending notes or calling/emailing the school.

Starting **Wednesday, September 7, 2022** staff will be using the **SafeArrival** notifications to let you know if your student is absent (when you haven't reported the absence in advance).

If you have children attending other schools, please continue to report absences using the existing procedures for those schools.

Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we implement this system in order to keep students as safe as we can.

SISTER MACNAMARA'S LUNCH PROGRAM



Just a few reminders:

- Lunch Program is a service provided for parents who are either working or attending school. In order to qualify for the Lunch Program you must be able to provide proof of either when filling out an application.
- Fees are 30.00 per month for the first child and 20.00 per month for each additional child. Fees are cash only and due at the first of each month. Please send exact amounts as we cannot make change.

Parents are expected to provide a healthy lunch, including a healthy beverage. (no junk food please!) The Lunch Program will not be supplying milk this year.

- The Lunch Program often has a waiting list. If fees are not paid promptly and become overdue, you risk the chance of losing your spot!

We understand that occasionally families might need to have their child stay for lunch. If the occasion arises, please call Ning, the lunch program coordinator, at least 24 hours in advance to make arrangements. Fees will apply.

We expect all students attending the lunch program to demonstrate proper behavior following the school and Lunch Program expectations: Be Respectful, Be Responsible, and Be Safe. If your child has any behavioral problems during the lunch program, you will be notified by either a phone call or a letter.

Also, a big thank you to all the lunch program staff for doing a wonderful job of ensuring your children are well taken care of during the lunch hour.


