# **English Language Arts**

Students will be exploring different aspects of English Language from grade 6 curriculum such as reading, writing, spelling and grammar by daily reading and writing activities independently and in small groups with teacher. We will be doing novel studies to expand vocabulary, improve reading and to improve comprehension skills.

## Math



Math helps students to develop problem solving skills in their daily life. Students will be studying four strands in math: Number Sense; which includes: addition, subtraction, division, multiplication, fractions, measurements, and problem solving; Patterns and Relations; Statistics, Probability; and Shape and Space.

# **Science**

Students will be exploring different topics in science by hands on experiments and research projects. In grade six students will learn about Diversity of living Things, Electricity, Air and flight, and exploring our Solar system.

# **Social Studies**

In social studies we will be learning about Canadian Confederation, role of Metis people and Louis Riel in creation of Manitoba. We will also be discussing about relation between Canadian government and various first Nation Groups in establishing Treaties in Western Canada.

#### Art

Students will learn about principles of design through colours, shapes and lines, dance, drama and we will also be doing many special projects.

### Health

In health we will learn about human body, discussing and practicing healthy eating habits and learning about safe use if technology.
