Science: (Grade 3) Students will study Growth and Changes in Plants, Materials

and Structures and Soils in the Environment.

(Grade 4) Students will study Habitats and Communities, materials and

structure, and Rocks, Minerals, and Erosion.

Math: Students will study the four strands in the math curriculum: Number

Sense; Patterns and Relations; Statistics and Probability; and Shape and Space which includes: addition, subtraction, division, multiplication, fractions, measurement, solving word problems and mental math.

Social Studies: (Grade 3) Students will cover the grade 3 curriculum: connecting with

Canadians, Communities of the World and Exploring an Ancient Society

(Grade 4) students will cover the grade 4 curriculum: Connecting with Canadians, exploring an ancient Society, Geography of Canada and

History of Manitoba.

Health: We will study the benefits of physical activities, healthy eating, personal

health practices such as proper hand washing, to prevent the spread the

germs and diseases.

Art: Students will learn about principles of design through colours, shapes and

lines. We will also be working with Ms. Bacchus on special projects.
