Parking For ÉSKS Grade 8 Farewell:


Parking is NOT allowed in the Tec Voc and Winnipeg School Division parking lots. All spots in these parking lots are paid and reserved stalls for staff who work in those buildings. The nearest parking opportunities are nearby residential streets.

A **"Lifting of Restrictions"** (special permit obtained for this event) has been granted for Wall Street between Wellington and Wall Street East, as well as Downing Street and Dominion Street between Yarwood and Notre Dame (marked on the map in yellow). Regardless of the posted one or two-hour time restriction limits, you WILL be okay to park there and well not get a parking ticket between **9:00am to 1:00pm**.

A number of the nearby residential streets such as Garfield Street North and Sherburn Street do not have any time restrictions for how long you may park (marked on the map in green).

Please be advised that this "Lifting of Restrictions" does not apply to the following:

- No Parking zones (including rush hour zones during posted times)
- No Stopping zones
 (including rush hour zones during posted times)
- Parking too close to a fire hydrant, stop sign or sidewalk
- Special circumstances such as construction or street cleaning would override the "Lifting of Restrictions"
- The "Lifting of Restrictions" does not apply if outstanding fines are present under a driver's account
