SCHOOL BUS CANCELLATIONS

During the school year there may be times when school bus transportation is cancelled due to inclement weather or poor driving conditions, but schools will remain open.

School bus transportation for all school divisions in the City of Winnipeg is cancelled when the wind chill reaches -45° Celsius by 6:15 a.m. based on the Environment Canada readings at the Winnipeg Airport. The temperature readings can be found at the Environment Canada website (http://www.weatheroffice.gc.ca).

Parents/Guardians can also phone the Transportation Department at 204-789-0442 for information.

Severe weather conditions and poor roads may extend the running time of some buses, resulting in late arrival and departure.

Parents/Guardians should make sure that children are suitably clothed until picked up and that they have a place to go in the event the bus does not arrive or is late. Parents/Guardians must also ensure that children have a place to go after the return trip.

Indoor recess

During the winter months, the wind chill is checked before morning recess, lunch time and afternoon recess.

Students are expected to dress appropriately for the weather at all times. As per WSD policy, students will be kept indoors only on inclement days when the wind chill reaches -28° Celsius. When the wind chill is between -25° to -27° , students may go out for a shortened 10 minute recess.

At times, parents and guardians have requested by a note to the classroom teacher or a phone call to the school, to have their child remain indoors at recess time. It is our school's belief that if a student is too sick to go outdoors at recess, then he or she is too sick to be at school.

We would ask parents and guardians to send children to school only when they are well enough to participate in all activities, including recess.

Lunch Program News ...

We would like to wish all parents and students a Happy New Year and a big thank you for all their support year round!

A couple of reminders, please be certain that your child has an adequate lunch, and just as importantly, proper utensils as single-use cutlery is no longer cheaply or easily accessible, so we are no longer able to provide multiple spoons and forks daily. During the colder months, elementary students will continue to go outside during the lunch hour, so it is essential that all children dress for the weather.

The safety and well being of all our students at ESKS is of the utmost importance. Therefore, if you are picking up your child, or giving them permission to leave the school, please sent a note, call the school or email the lunch program at eskslunchprogram@gmail.com

If you would like your child to stay at the school during the lunch hour, the lunch program is available on a full-time basis at a cost of **\$280.00** for the year.

Student Safety

At École Stanley Knowles School, our first priority is to ensure the safety of your children while they are in school.

With safety in mind, The Winnipeg School Division and the Province of Manitoba require that each school have procedures in place to use in situations where students' safety could be compromised.

Patrols and Adult Crossing Guards

Adult crossing guards are on duty at the following times:

Morning: Afternoon:

8:30 am - 9:00 am 12:30 pm - 12:45 pm 11:45 am - 12:00 noon 3:30 pm - 3:45 pm


It is extremely important that children who cross busy streets to get to school do so at specified corners where patrols are on duty.

In order to protect the safety and welfare of the children, we emphasize the following:

- ✓ Please arrange for your children to arrive at school during the times that there are Patrols/Crossing Guards and Teachers/EAs on duty.
- We ask that parents/guardians who walk and pick up their children from school, use the crosswalks at the intersections, and not cross where there are no crosswalks. Modelling safe crossing will teach the children pedestrian safety.

Especially during the winter months, we have a more challenging time crossing the children, so we ask your cooperation in being respectful to our Crossing Guards.

Crossing Guards have been instructed to take the license plate number of any vehicle who is not showing respect or courtesy to them. If this happens, you can expect a visit by the Winnipeg Police Service.



Students' Arrival at School

Students are to arrive at school **No Earlier** than 8:50 a.m. and 12:40 p.m.

This becomes particularly important in the winter months when the cold weather has arrived and it is not safe for students to remain outside. Students will not be allowed in until adult supervision is available at 8:45 a.m.

There is NO supervision at the school until 8:50 a.m. and 12:40 p.m.

Students must exit the school and grounds for their own safety promptly at 3:30 pm as there is NO supervision after school hours.

Loading Zones and Dropping Off Children

- DO NOT enter the Bus Loop when picking up or dropping off students.

 Vehicles found parked in the Bus Loop or in the Staff Parking lot are subject to being ticketed and towed at the owner's expense.
- Children are dismissed onto the playground. Parents/guardians are asked to wait for their children on the playground and then walk to their parked vehicle or walk home together.
- ✓ PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL.
- ✓ DO NOT MAKE U-TURNS AT INKSTER OR KINVER OFF OF KING EDWARD.
- ✓ DO NOT USE THE TYNDALL GREENS PRIVATE PARKING LOT ON KING EDWARD AND KINVER TO DROP OFF, PICK UP, OR TURN AROUND IN.
- ✓ PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY AND BE PATIENT.




<u>Asessippi Ski Area and Winter Park</u>
