# **SENIOR HIGH PROGRAM**

Students have the unique opportunity to earn both an <u>Academic</u> and a <u>Technical-Vocational Diploma</u> while learning at Tec-Voc High School. We offer a variety of Academic and Technical Vocational programs that may lead to further study at a University, Community College, Apprenticeship, or employment.

Students must complete 30 credits to graduate high school. Students who register in an Academic program may choose from a full range of courses including those required for university entrance. To graduate with a Technical diploma, students must obtain 8 credits in a specific program.

Please read the Tec-Voc Student Handbook and talk to your guidance counsellor to make informed decisions about your courses.
