

AMMOP Application Process 2023



STEP 1. Attend the AMMOP OPEN HOUSE on *APRIL 26, 2023* at Tec-Voc High School 6:00pm Presentation. Pick up an *application form*.

STEP 2. Submit your application and supporting documents.

Please submit the following documents with your completed application form:

- Resume
- Educational Certificate/Transcripts (Grade 12, College, etc.)
- Permanent Resident Certificate (if applicable)

IMPORTANT: Please submit your application by May 19, 2023!

STEP 3. Interviews and entrance tests will take place on *May 31 and June 1, 2023*. Morning, afternoon and evening timeslots will be available. You will be contacted by *email* to book an interview time.

Assessment includes: an interview with instructors/industry and a written assessment of your reading/document use, problem-solving, mechanical reasoning and basic math skills.

STEP 4. If selected for the program:

You will be asked to attend an Orientation Session in June and will start working on upgrading your skills over the summer. In class-training will begin **September 6, 2023.**

If not selected for the program:

You are encouraged to work on upgrading various skills (language, math, literacy) and apply to AMMOP the following year.
