

School Bus Cancellations

During the school year, there may be times when school bus transportation is cancelled due to inclement weather or poor driving conditions, but schools will remain open. School bus transportation for all school divisions in the City of Winnipeg is cancelled:

- A. If the actual temperature is -35°C (regardless of windchill) based on the 6:00AM Environment Canada reading at the Forks, Winnipeg.
 or:
- **B.** If the windchill reaches -45°C (regardless of air temperature) based on the 6:00AM Environment Canada reading at the Forks, Winnipeg.

The temperature and windchill readings can be found at the Environment Canada website based on The Forks location. When bus transportation is cancelled in the morning, it will not resume later in the day even if weather conditions improve.

All major Winnipeg media outlets are contacted in the early morning and are asked that they broadcast and/or post bus cancellation information. The Winnipeg School Division website (www.winnipegsd.ca) will also post any cancellations.
