In addition, we have a number of Educational Assistants, two office clerks, and 4 custodians. Our school is further supported by staff at Clinical Support Services.

The YMCA operates a Before and After School program during the school year and our Lunch Program is run by our Parent Council.

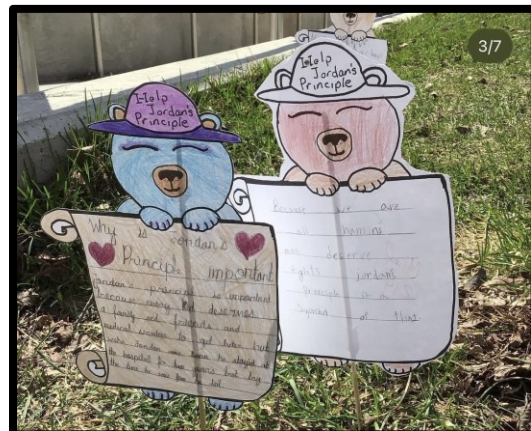
Our Parent Council organizes various fund-raising events during the school year. PAC has fundraised for our new nature playground, which was installed in May 2020.

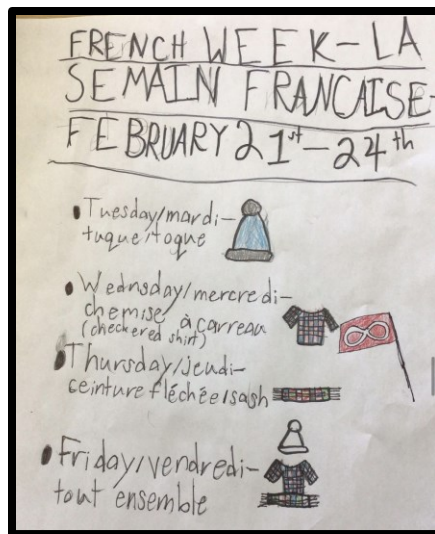

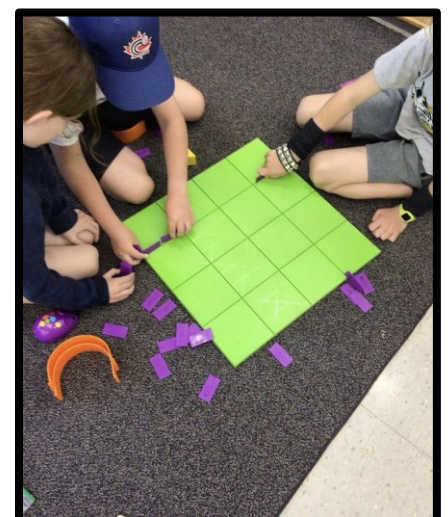
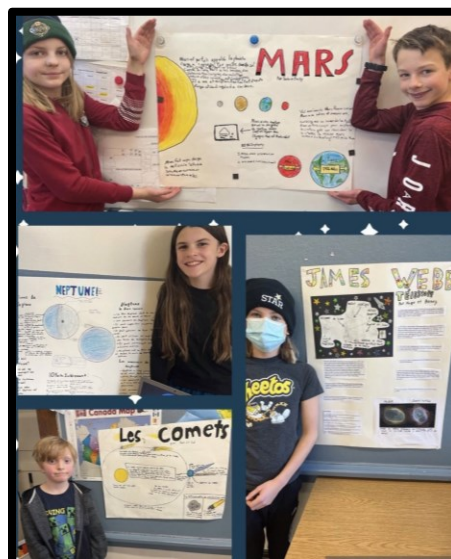
School priorities for the 2022-2023 school year:
