Practicum Days

Practicum days occur twice a month for each grade at various health care facilities in and around Winnipeg. These days include:

Practicing Skills

Students have the opportunity to learn new skills and test their knowledge in hands-on practicum settings.

Shadowing

Students get the opportunity to shadow professionals at work, from a surgeon in the operating room, to a respiratory therapist working directly with a patient.

Coursework

Students who are accepted into MCEP must be enrolled in the following courses:

- Virtual Medical Course
- Lifeworks
- Career Development (Grade 11 & 12)

Recommended courses for postsecondary healthcare programs:

- Intro to Applied Pre-Calculus
- Applied/Pre-Calculus Math
- Biology and/or Chemistry



Scholarships

Financial challenges can often be a barrier for students when considering postsecondary education. MCEP works in partnership with the Winnipeg School Division and program funders to maximize available scholarship opportunities for those graduating and entering postsecondary. Students receive \$1,000 for each year of the program they complete (up to \$3,000). Additionally, The Pan Am Clinic Foundation offers two separate scholarships that students can apply for.

MCEP Events

There are multiple events throughout the year that we facilitate for students and their families. These include Opening & Closing Pipe Ceremonies, CPR Certification, Family Information Evening, Camp Manitou, Career Day and a Live Surgery.
