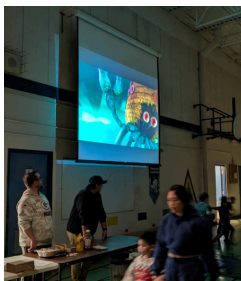

Vision Clinic

Our Vision Clinic will take place on Wednesday, April 22, bringing valuable eye care services directly to our students through the Winnipeg School Division (WSD) Mobile Vision Care Unit. This program was created after WSD Student Services identified a significant need for accessible vision care in schools, and it is now supporting students across 20 schools. The clinic provides comprehensive eye examinations at no cost, as they are billed directly to Manitoba Health, and also helps ensure students receive prescription eyewear through insurance, assistance programs, or donations. Thanks to this initiative, students are better supported in their learning, with over 100 pairs of glasses already donated this year alone.
