From the games, bouncers, and face painting to the delicious baking and other activities, there was something for everyone to enjoy. Events like these help strengthen the connections that make our school community so special.

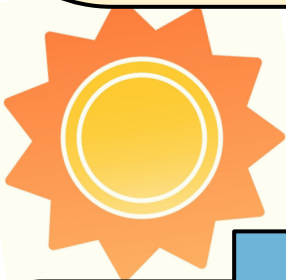
