Gr N-7 students have physical education classes every other day.

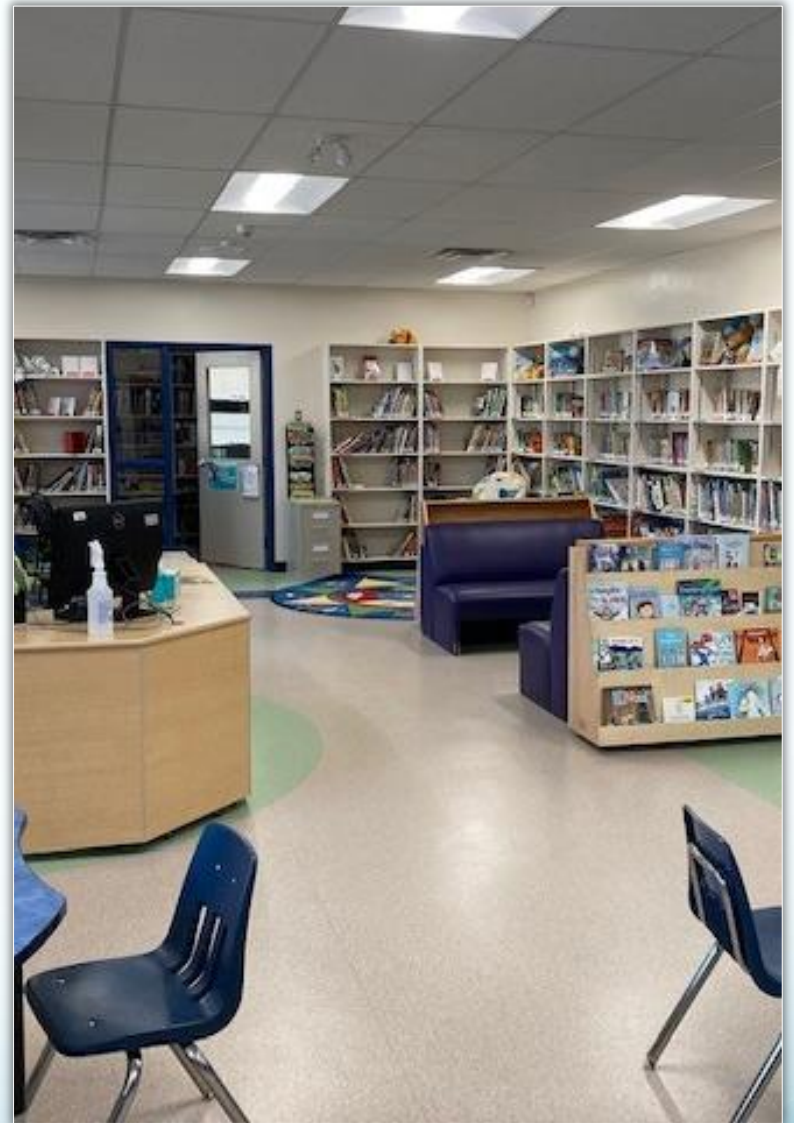
We are very excited to get into our new full sized gymnasium so that our middle years students can have full sports opportunities!

# About École Sir William Osler

- École Sir William Osler officially opened as a French Immersion Milieu in the fall of 2015 with students in Nursery, Kindergarten and Grade 1. We now house children in Nursery to Grade 7.
- At our milieu school, **all** subjects are taught in French (French Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, Health, Art, Music, and Physical Education). English Language Arts is one hour per day for Grades 1-8. Nursery and Kindergarten are taught only in French.
- Bussing is available for qualifying students. Your **home address** must be at least 1.6km from the school and be in the catchment area.

# French Immersion Milieu

- French Immersion is designed for students whose first language is **not** French.
- The entire student population is enrolled in the French Immersion program.
- Students are immersed in the French language throughout the day.
- **All** subjects are taught in French (with the exception of one hour of ELA beginning in Grade 1).
- Report cards and all other communication with parents is in English.

# Registration Information

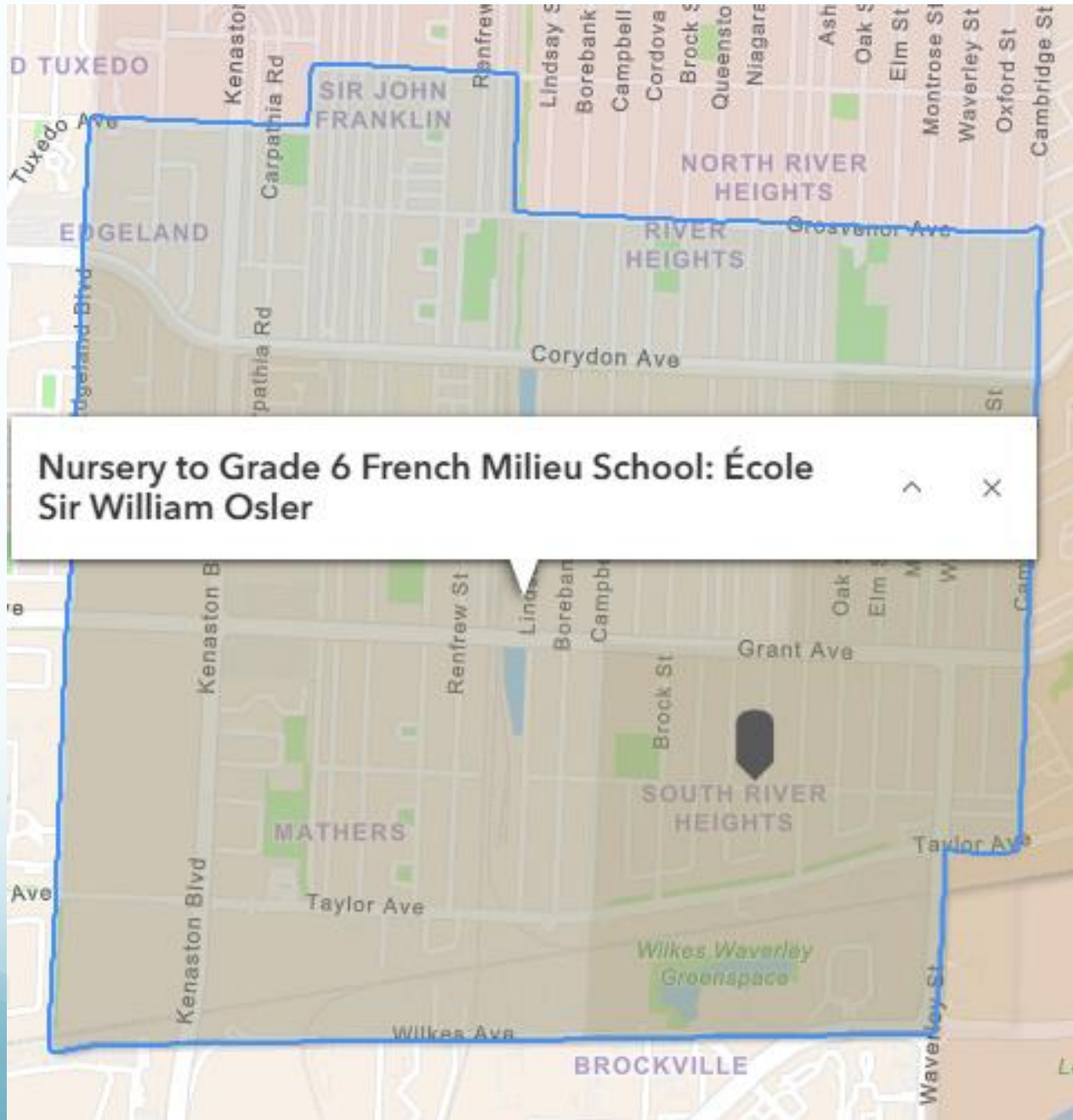
- Entry points for the early French Immersion program are the beginning of **Nursery, Kindergarten or up until December of Grade 1.**
- In order to register for Nursery, your child must be 4 by December 31, 2026 (born between January and December 2022).
- In order to register for Kindergarten, your child must be 5 by December 31, 2026 (born between January and December 2021).
- All registration is online.

# Catchment Area - Nursery

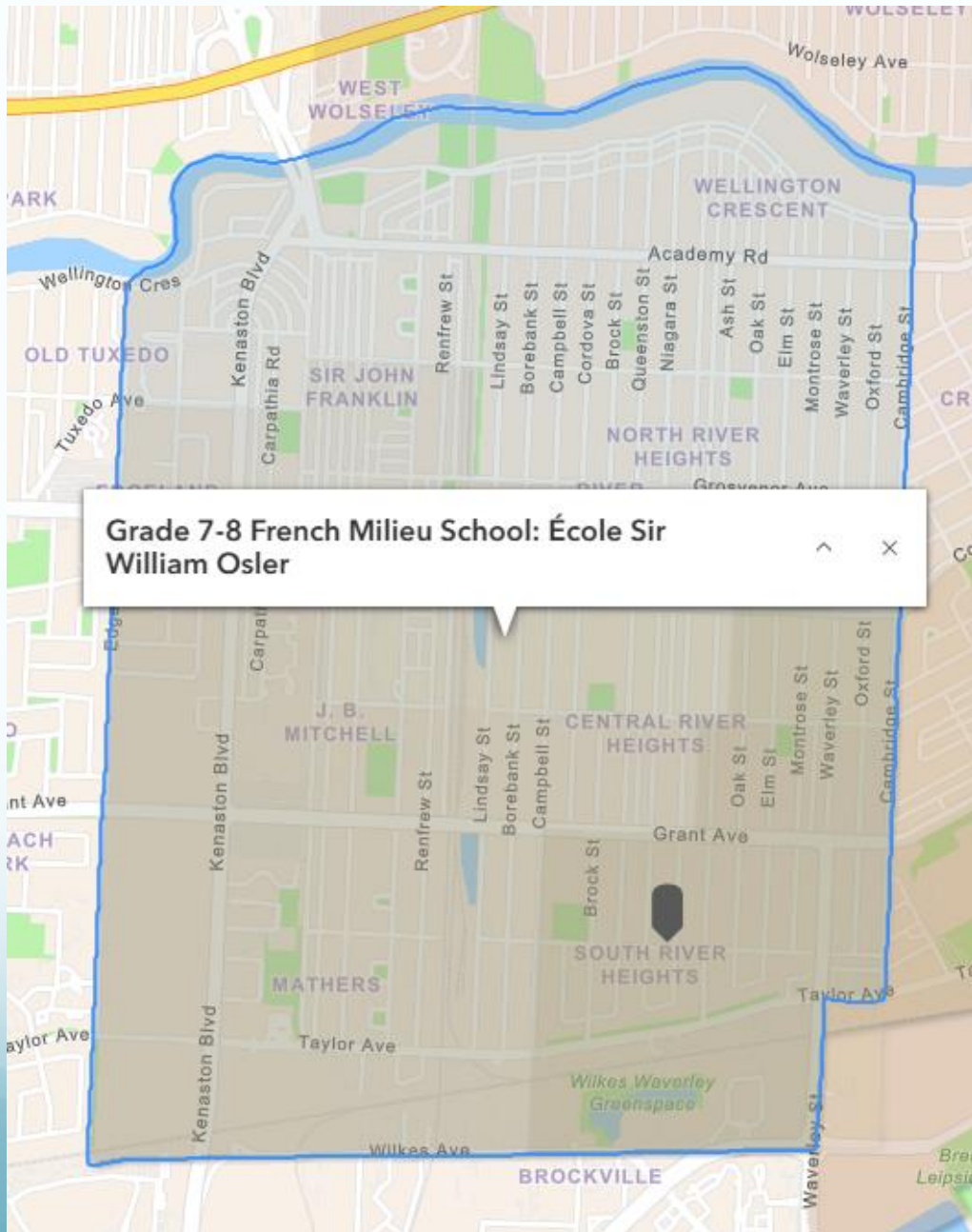
- Nursery is a Winnipeg School Division program. First priority is given to families that reside in the catchment for our school.
- Students that live out of catchment may be admitted if there is space available. Families must submit a Schools of Choice form to the Winnipeg School Division.
- Nursery is not a provincially funded program, so it is only available to residents of the Winnipeg School Division. Others may attend if space is available and fees apply.
- Because it is not a provincially funded program, no additional supports are provided. Inclusive Education supports begin in kindergarten for students already with or pursuing a diagnosis under FSE (First School Experience) supports.

# Kindergarten to Grade 7 French Immersion Catchment

- Priority will be given to families residing in our catchment area.
- Families living outside the catchment area must complete a Schools of Choice form and submit it to the school division.
- N-6 catchment area: Wilkes Ave on the south. Edgeland Blvd on the west. Cambridge Street on the east. North side is: Tuxedo to Lockwood, north to Kingsway, east to Renfrew, south to Grosvenor east to Cambridge. It will include the new development of the previous Kapyong Barracks.
- Gr 7-8 catchment area is the same on the west, south and east, but the north boundary extends up to the Assiniboine River.

# How can I help my child be ready for school?

- Take your child for an eye exam before they begin school and then once every year afterwards.
- Teach your child to dress themselves, to put on shoes, carry and hang up their outdoor clothing and backpack.
- Read to your child every day. Make reading a fun and special time.
- Practice the ABC's, nursery rhymes, and rhyming games.
- Play games involving counting and recognizing numbers and dice patterns.
- Colour, cut, paste and create. Use playdoh, lego and recycled materials to encourage imagination and creativity.
- Participate in fun **outdoor** adventures together.
- Make sure your child gets a good sleep each night - children age 3-5 require 10-13 hours per night and children 6-13 require 9-11 hours per night.
