Dear Gladstone Families,

Happy New Year! I hope you were able to enjoy the winter break and maybe get outside during some of the warmer days. As we jump back into learning I would like to continue sharing about the numeracy journey we are on at Gladstone this year. A math resource that I have found helpful is by an organization called “Make Math Moments”. They have a website, great snippets on their Instagram as well as detailed content on their podcast. On their website they use a tree to describe what they describe as the 6 parts of an effective math program. I’d like to share two of them.



### Knowledge & Proficiency

#### Roots

The roots in this model are to continually be growing in our mathematical knowledge and proficiency and to transfer this understanding to our students. As I spoke of in December’s newsletter, our participation in “Math Up” has been instrumental in addressing this key aspect of our numeracy programming at Gladstone. We have also been looking at how we collect and track student growth and then how to use this data to drive our programming.

Mindset and Beliefs are seen as the elements that feed a healthy math program. There is a focus here on shifting from deficit to asset thinking.

When we are looking at the strengths we have as a staff and are helping each student to also see their own unique gifts. This focus has gone beyond math as all teachers have created strength-based profiles for individual students and for their classes as a whole. We believe that seeking to work from areas we feel confident and competent gives us a foundation from which to lean into ideas and concepts we find more challenging. I encourage

you to check in with your child to see what they feel their strengths are and how they have been able to work on these during their school day!
