Language is the single best predictor of school achievement. The key to strong language skills are those back-and-forth fluent conversations between young children and their caregivers. Talking and listening to children does a lot of important things. It improves your bond with them, and encourages them to listen to you. It helps them to form relationships and to build self-esteem. It also teaches important turn-taking skills. Keep the art of conversation alive between you and your children by saying, "tell me about the best part of your day!" You will be surprised at all the great conversations you can have.

We are pleased to welcome Vilma Soto, who will be joining our Nursery/Kindergarten team, teaching in 109 p.m. We were fortunate to be given an additional term Teacher to support all the diverse needs as well as the large number of students registered for Nusery/Kindergarten.

The report card is a snapshot of where your child(ren) current achievement is in a primarily academic domain (Math, Language Arts, Science etc.). We would like to invite you to join us in celebrating the strengths, challenges and next steps of our learners as it pertains to their academic AND social-emotional well-being. We would also love for you to share any insights or ask questions to help support us working together to improve the academic and social-emotional well-being of our children.
