


## **Terry Fox Run**

#### SAFETY IN THE SCHOOL

As we continue into the fall, I would like to share some important reminders about our safety practices. The safety and well-being of our students, staff, and visitors is our priority. To ensure everyone is prepared in case of an emergency, schools are required to complete the following drills:

**Fire Drills:** Schools must complete ten fire drills each school year, one each month from September to June. These drills must be held before the 20th of each month. Practicing regularly helps ensure that everyone knows how to exit the building quickly and safely in case of a fire.

**Lockdown Drills:** Three lockdown drills are required each year. One is completed at the beginning of the school year, another after the Christmas break, and the third after the spring break. These drills help us prepare in the unlikely event that we need to secure our school building.

**Hold & Secure Drills:** Three hold & secure drills are also required each year, following the same schedule as the lockdown drills (beginning of the year, after Christmas, and after spring break). A hold & secure is used when there is a potential safety concern in the community but not directly inside the school.

We know that practicing these drills can sometimes feel unsettling, but they are a very important part of ensuring our school remains a safe and caring place for learning. We appreciate your support in talking with your children about the importance of these practices and reassuring them that drills are simply a way for us to be prepared.
