Thus, we are looking for parent coaches/helpers to help with extracurricular/sports teams. We offer sports teams that participate in divisional leagues for our grade 7 and 8 students, and sports teams for mini tournaments for our students in grades 5 and 6.

You will need a Police Information/Vulnerable Sector Check and Child Abuse Registry, and to complete the Respect in Sport program.

Respect in Sport:

The Respect in Sport program is mandatory for anyone wishing to help coach. It is a free online program that ensures aspiring coaches understand the appropriate behaviors and athletic practices that are expected of coaches in the Winnipeg School Division.

The program certification is valid for 5 years, with modules that can be completed at a pace that is convenient for you. Total completion time is roughly 2 hours.
