Honours outstanding scholastic achievement. The most prestigious award that students in Canadian schools can receive, the Collegiate Bronze Medal honours the top academic student. The Kelvin 75th Anniversary Reunion Scholarship is given to the recipient of the Governor General's Medal.

Recognizes the importance of cultural and creative talents; presented to a students who embody a passion for musical arts, be it vocal, instrumental or musical theatre, while achieving and maintaining a high level of academic performance.

CGC AWARD OF MERIT

Recognizes a student who has shown resilience and determination in the face of adversity.

CHOWN CENTENNIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Acknowledges a top honours student enrolling at the University of Manitoba.

CITIZEN OF THE YEAR AWARD

Given for demonstrating community leadership, high standards of integrity and respect for others, and a willingness to speak to social issues.

EXCELLENCE IN FRENCH AWARD (provided by the Souchay Gossen Foundation)

Celebrates a student in the French Immersion Program who demonstrates excellence in both written and oral communication.

FRED G. GILBERT MEMORIAL BURSARY

Established in memory of a former Kelvin teacher, is awarded for outstanding character, aptitude and academics.

GRANT HERMANSON ART AWARD

Established in memory of a former Kelvin student, is presented for outstanding achievement in art.

CAROLE ISAAC MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Established in honour of a former Kelvin student, is awarded to a female student with outstanding grades in chemistry, mathematics, and physics who intends to enter university.

KELVIN COFFEE HOUSE AWARD

Celebrates a student who has made significant contributions to the Coffee House events.

KELVIN HIGH SCHOOL STAFF AWARD

Awarded to a deserving student at the discretion of the Kelvin High School Awards Committee.

KELVIN JUBILEE AWARD-BURSARY

Awarded to a university-bound student with high academic standing.

KELVIN JUBILEE AWARD-SCHOLARSHIP

Awarded to a university-bound student with high academic standing.

KELVIN STUDENT COUNCIL AWARD

Recognizes involvement in student government and school activities.

LIFETOUCH GRAD PORTRAIT SCHOLARSHIPS

Awarded for excellence in academics, citizenship and integrity.

MANITOBA SCHOOL BOARDS ASSOCIATION (MSBA) STUDENT CITIZENSHIP AWARD

Recognizes outstanding young people in Manitoba who are active participants in their schools and communities.

THE MEDICAL CAREERS EXPLORATION PROGRAM (MCEP) MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

Recognizes students for their commitment to the Medical Careers Exploration Program and who are entering postsecondary studies.

THE SHAROO MODHA COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

In honour of Sharoo Modha, this scholarship is awarded to a student who has demonstrated a commitment to the community in some way which deserves recognition.

ALICE OSBORNE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP—established in memory of a former Kelvin teacher and awarded to the Kelvin High School Valedictorian.

PROGRAM EXCELLENCE AWARD, CREE SPEAKER 9—12—

recognizes an individual who has achieved excellence in language revitalization for the Cree language.

ELIZABETH SCHACHTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Recognizes a student in an advanced academic program who is involved in school and/or community activities and who is planning to study science or education.

SCHOOL BOARD BOOK AWARDS FOR SCHOLASTIC ACHIEVEMENT

Awarded by the Trustees of the Winnipeg School Division to honour high academic success.

ALLAN BRETT SERBIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Established in memory of a former Kelvin student, awarded to a student with active extra-curricular involvement and who has registered at a post-secondary institution.

SOUCHAY GOSSEN FOUNDATION AWARD

Recognizes a student who demonstrates commitment to education and engagement in the school community and the community at large.

UNIVERSITY OF TORONTO NATIONAL BOOK AWARD

Recognizes students who excel in academic pursuits, demonstrate enthusiasm for intellectual exploration and have a strong involvement in the lives of their school and communities.

WELCOME HAND SCHOLARSHIP

Established specifically for a student who was not born in Canada, who shows a commitment to education as evidenced by consistent attendance and good achievement.
