



## 2023/24 SERIOUS INCIDENT REPORT

In accordance with the Manitoba Department of Education and Early Childhood Learning requirements, schools must report all serious incidents to the division.

In 2023/24, a total of **211 serious incidents** were reported. Schools indicated between one and five reasons for each incident. In total, **304 reasons were reported**.

### Frequency of Serious Incidents

In 2023/24, **65** out of **78** WSD schools reported serious incidents.

This represents **83.3%** of all WSD schools.

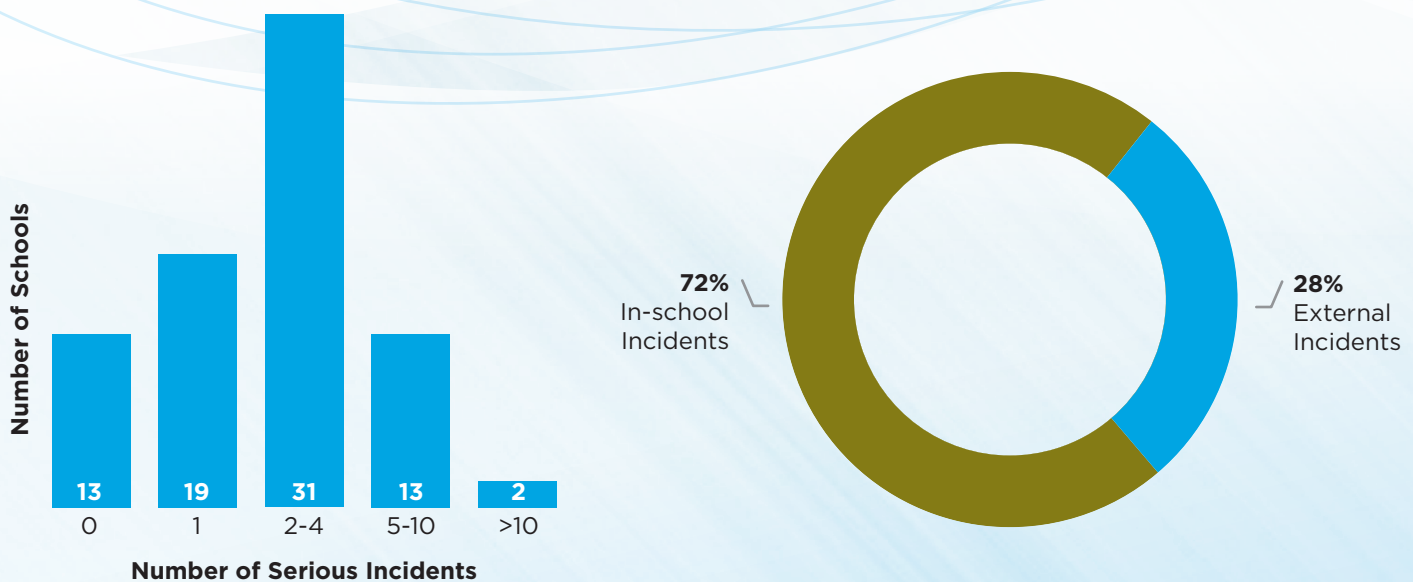
### Where do Serious Incidents Occur?

Serious incidents are categorized as either an in-school incident or external incident.

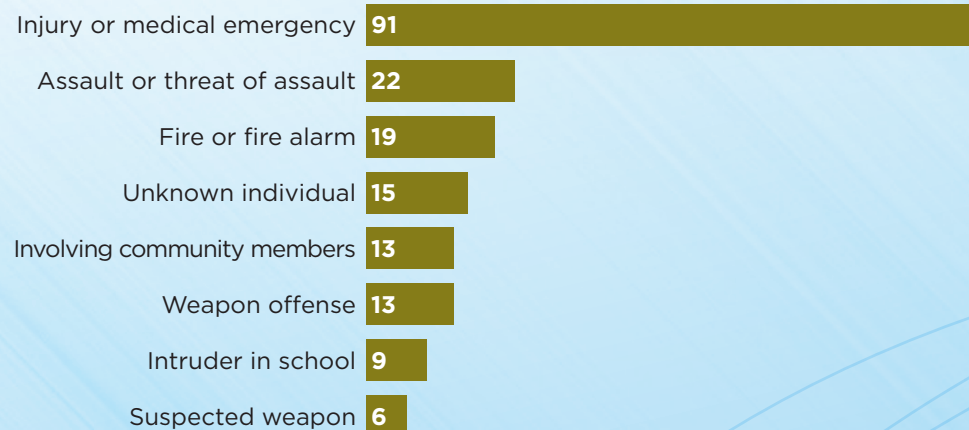
In-school incidents happen on school premises, during school hours or school-related activities (e.g. field trips, sport events, etc), or when students travel to and from school via school bus.

External incidents occur off school premises that are reported by schools and impact the school environment (e.g. student or staff fatality, car accidents, incidents walking to and from school, etc).

In 2023/24, there were **152 in-school incidents** (72%) and **59 external incidents** (28%).
